Making Mud Pies

C.S. Lewis, the great 20th century Christian writer, captured our often-lukewarm response to God's invitation in this apt metaphor, paraphrased here: "It would seem that Our Lord finds our desires not too strong, but too weak. We are half-hearted creatures, fooling about . . . when infinite joy is offered us, like an ignorant child who wants to go on making mud pies in a slum because he cannot imagine what is meant by the offer of a holiday at the sea. We are far too easily pleased."
