EASTER DUTY

Due to the central importance of Easter to the Christian faith, the Catholic Church requires that all Catholics who have made their First Communion receive the Holy Eucharist sometime during the Easter season, which lasts through Pentecost Sunday, 50 days after Easter (Church Law extends the time when this duty may be fulfilled until Trinity Sunday, an extra two weeks!). They should also take part in the Sacrament of Penance before receiving this Easter Communion. This reception of the Eucharist is a visible sign of our faith and our participation in the Kingdom of God. Of course, we should receive Communion as frequently as possible (as long as we are in the state of grace); this "Easter Duty" is simply the minimum requirement set by the Church.

Statement of Cardina Dolan and the NYS Bishops on State-Sanctioned Suicide Bill

Signed by the 8 Bishops of the New York Dioceses.

Please pray that this Medical Aid in Dying fails to pass. "Euthanasia and assisted suicide are a defeat for all. We are called never to abandon those who are suffering, never giving up but caring and loving to restore hope." – Pope Francis, 2019.

The New York State Assembly will take up legislation (A136/S138) to legalize state sanctioned suicide for those who are diagnosed with a terminal illness. Euphemistically titled the Medical Aid in Dying Act, this bill would usher in a dangerous new era in our state turning the Hippocratic Oath taken by physicians to "do no harm" on its head and leaving vulnerable individuals – people with disabilities, the elderly, and those in impoverished and underserved communities – subject to pressure and coercion to end their lives so as not to be a "burden" to society or an excessive cost to insurance companies.

Canada passed a similar law to New York's bill in 2016. Within a few short years, it was expanded to allow not only those with terminal illnesses, but also those with "chronic" illnesses, such as arthritis, to end their lives. In 2027, the law is set to expand to those whose only underlying condition is mental illness, such as depression, anxiety or anorexia....

We are facing a suicide crisis among young people in our state, and the government rightly spends large sums of money to prevent these tragedies and to deliver a consistent message that life is worth living. Now our state will be telling its citizens that some lives are not worth living. We pray that the legislature reconsiders this disastrous public policy. And we call on Governor Hochul to exercise her veto authority should the bill come to her desk. Contact call or email Senator Harckham at 518-455-2340, email harckham@nysenate.gov. When the Assembly passed the bill May 1, Assemblyman Slater voted No. Ask Senator Harckham to also vote NO.




