TRINITY SUNDAY

Trinity Sunday, officially called "The Solemnity of the Most Holy Trinity," is one of the few celebrations of the Christian Year that commemorates a reality and doctrine rather than a person or event. Today, Christians remember and honor the eternal God: the Father, the Son, and the Holy Spirit. While the word "trinity" does not appear in Scripture, it is taught in Matthew 28:18-20 and 2 Corinthians 13:14 along with many other Bible passages.

The concept of the Holy Trinity can never be completely understood. That is the mystery. But it is clearly taught in Scripture and explained in Tradition. Understanding this comes through the work of the Holy Spirit; therefore, it is appropriate that this mystery is celebrated the first Sunday after Pentecost, when the outpouring of the Holy Spirit first occurred.

However, although we ponder the Most Holy Trinity on this special day, we commemorate the Trinity at every Eucharist. By its very nature, every Holy Mass is Trinitarian: when we offer TO the FATHER, WITH the SON (as part of His Mystical Body), IN the HOLY SPIRIT.
