#### **FAMILY MASS CONCLUDES FOR THE SEASON**

The 10:00am Mass on Sunday, June 29<sup>th</sup> will be the last Family Mass for this season. It will resume in October. Therefore, the 10:00am Mass will continue as a usual Sunday Mass.

### TO THE PARENTS OF OUR YOUNG CHILDREN, MAY WE SUGGEST ...

Relax! God put the wiggle in children, don't feel you have to suppress it in God's house. All are welcome!

- +Sit towards the front where it is easier for the little ones to see and to hear what's going on at the altar. They tire of seeing the backs of other's heads.
- +Quietly explain the parts of the Mass and the actions of the priest, altar servers, choir, etc.
- +Open up the Missalettes and have the children follow and read the Mass responses and prayers. Help them to follow the hymn texts.
- +Sing the hymns, pray and voice the responses. Children learn liturgical behavior by copying you.
- +Do not miss the opportunity to socialize the children into the Christian community.
- +If you have to leave Mass with your child, feel free to do so, but please come back. As Jesus said: "let the children come to me."
- +Remember that the way we welcome children in church directly affects the way they respond to the Church, to God and to one another. Let them know that they are at home in this house of worship. Help them to realize that the parish is a family and that all these people care about them and are there to help them

#### TO THE MEMBERS OF OUR PARISH FAMILY:

- +The presence of children is a gift to the Church and they are a reminder that our parish is alive and growing!
- +Remember that the children are watching you! Children learn what it means to be Catholic by watching Catholics.
- +Young married couples, get to know the other couples in the parish.

#### **BUILDINGS AND GROUNDS**

#### St. James Church

- 1. We have replaced the failed Air Conditioning unit over the baptismal font entrance with a 12.5-ton Heil HVAC unit that will provide both air conditioning and supplementary heat. A new gas line was installed to accommodate this unit. Funds left over from prior projects were used to pay for the bulk of this installation.
- 2. We have contracted repairs for the chapel and parish office roofs after wind damage this winter. Part of the work will be covered by insurance.

#### Our Lady of the Lake / Mt. Carmel

1. The parish Finance Council has authorized the use of Renew & Rebuild funds to repair and upgrade OLL. We have begun lining up contractors for roof repairs, interior painting, nave wood floor replacement, sanctuary rug removal, and sanctuary wood floor refinishing. The building will have to be closed for a few weeks during the summer to accomplish this work. More information to follow.

#### **All Grounds**

1. Our Garden Committee has been hard at work cleaning up planting beds, planning the beds, planting flowers & plants, and strategically adding perennials to help keep future costs down.

Our St. Sebastian Columbarium families have been particularly appreciative of the attention given to that sacred site. A special note of thanks to all our loyal gardeners.



## Peter's Confession of Christ

Jesus asked His disciples, "Who do people say the Son of Man is?"



1.B
