# July is the Month of the Precious Blood of Jesus

The feast of the Precious Blood was instituted in 1849 by Pius IX, but the devotion is as old as Christianity.

The early Fathers say that the Church was born from the pierced side of Christ, and that the sacraments were brought forth through His Blood. "The Precious Blood which we worship is the Blood which the Savior shed for us on Calvary and reassumed at His glorious Resurrection; it is the Blood which courses through the veins of His risen, glorified, living body at the right hand of God the Father in heaven; it is the Blood made present on our altars by the words of Consecration; it is the Blood which merited sanctifying grace for us and through it washes and beautifies our soul and inaugurates the beginning of eternal life in it."

Through the merits of the Precious Blood, our prayers of petition take on great power before the throne of God when they are accompanied by sacrifice and penance.

#### Prayer of Protection by the Precious Blood

Lord JESUS, by faith in your merits, I now take your Precious Blood and sprinkle it over myself and my family right from the crown of my head to the very soles of my feet. I claim total and complete protection for my life and my family. Lord JESUS, keep me free today from evil, sin, temptation, Satan's attacks and afflictions, fear of darkness, fear of man, sickness, diseases, doubts, anger, all calamities and from all that is not of thy Kingdom. Fill me Lord JESUS with the gift of your Holy Spirit and grant me the gift of wisdom, knowledge, understanding, and discernment so that I will live today in your glory by doing that which is right. Praise you Jesus. Thank You Jesus.


