RENEW + REBUILD REMEMBRING THE ARCHDIOCESAN WIDE CAMPAIGN

The \$200 million capital campaign was launched in 2017 to revitalize and strengthen parishes and address various archdiocesan priorities. The campaign focused on improving parish facilities, supporting Catholic schools, clergy, and Catholic Charities, and promoting evangelization and lay leadership.

Here's a more detailed breakdown:

Goal:

The primary goal is to raise \$200 million to support parish improvements, Catholic schools, clergy, evangelization, and Catholic Charities.

Parish Focus:

A significant portion of the funds, \$130 million, will be directly allocated to individual parish needs for renovations, updates, and technological improvements.

Archdiocesan Priorities:

The remaining funds will support other key areas, including:

Needy Parishes: Providing financial assistance to needy parishes facing capital needs.

Catholic Schools: Supporting Catholic education within the Archdiocese.

Clergy: Addressing the needs of St. Joseph's Seminary and the St. John Vianney Center for Retired Priests.

Evangelization and Lay Leadership: Fostering the next generation of Church leaders.

Catholic Charities: Supporting the charitable ministries of the Archdiocese.

St. Patrick's Cathedral: Restoring and maintaining the cathedral.

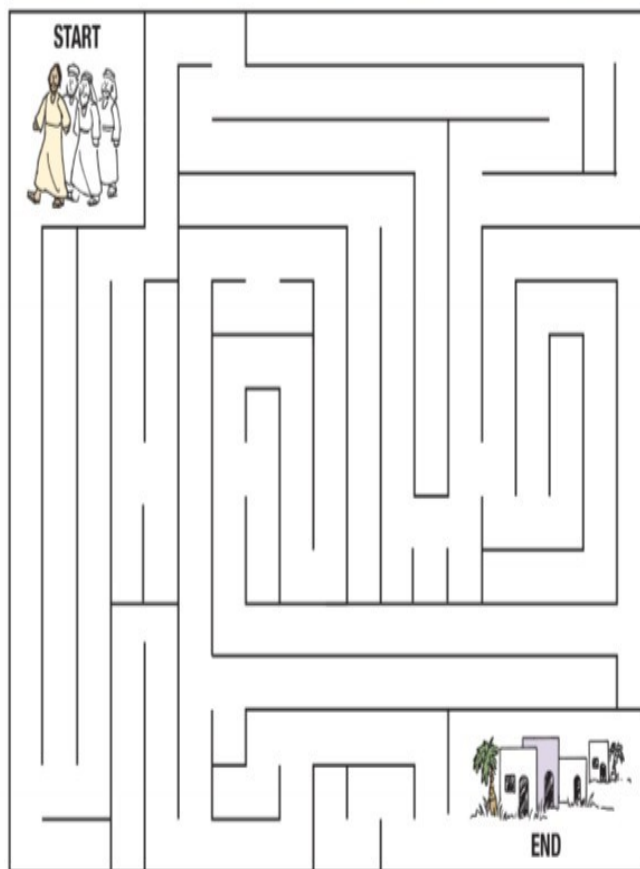
