ADMINISTRATION OF THE SACRAMENTS

- **Baptism** • We welcome all families with young children. For your first step, you must become a registered, practicing, contributing member of St. Rose of Lima. Your second step is to contact Tessie in the office, 851-1874, to schedule and get a baptism packet. **Be sure you provide all the necessary documents 10 days prior to the baptism class.** Baptism class is the 2nd Thursday of every month at 6 PM. ***Reservations are needed for the class.*** At least one godparent must be a practicing Catholic. All baptisms are celebrated on the 1st, 2nd, 3rd, & 4th Sunday of each month at 12 noon, after the 10:30 Mass. **No baptisms during Lent.**
- **Matrimony** • At least one party must be a registered, practicing member of St. Rose with at least 6 months active proven attendance at Mass. After this is accomplished, please call Jane Lucero to make an appointment to begin your 6 month marriage preparation process. *Please make no arrangements until after this appointment.* You may pick up a marriage packet in the parish office. *Engaged Encounter* weekend is required: www.renoee.org for dates, times and registration.
- **Anointing of the Sick** • It is best to call at the *beginning* of a serious illness or when surgery is first scheduled.
- ♦ **Funerals** • Upon the death of a loved one, please call the Parish Office to make arrangements, 851-1874.

THE RESPONSIBILITY OF OUR FAITH

Today is a day simply to ponder the fact that in baptism we were claimed by God: Father, Son, and Holy Spirit. The first reading from Deuteronomy prompts us to fix in our hearts the truth that God is the Lord of both heaven and earth and there is no other god. Saint Paul reminds us that, because we received the Spirit of adoption in baptism, we are now children of God. In the Gospel Jesus charges us with the responsibility to make other disciples. These realities make today's solemnity a day of praise, adoration, and responsibility. It is a fitting day to thank God for the absolutely free gift of faith that we were given in baptism. It is also a day to ask God for strength to take on the responsibility of sharing that faith with others.

TREASURES FROM OUR TRADITION

One of the great treasures of the Eastern tradition is the icon of the Holy Trinity created by the Russian iconographer Andrei Rublev in the 1400s. The Trinity is symbolized by the three travelers to the tent of Abraham and Sarah. They are seated at a table blessing a cup of wine, under the oak of Mamre. If you look closely, you will see a sacrificed calf in the chalice, reminding the viewer of the cross. The table, prepared for eating and tilted toward the viewer, is an invitation to the Eucharist. From left to right, each figure is keyed to a person of the Trinity. Like all icons, this image is theology in art. The persons are equal in proportion and dignity, they all carry staffs to symbolize their power, and are shown with golden wings and halos. Today, the best place to see Rublev's work is the Holy Trinity Cathedral, at the heart of the vast Holy Trinity monastery about an hour from Moscow. After decades of persecution, it is now once again a living monastery, a world heritage site, and the spiritual home of Russian Orthodoxy. A Google visit is highly recommended today!

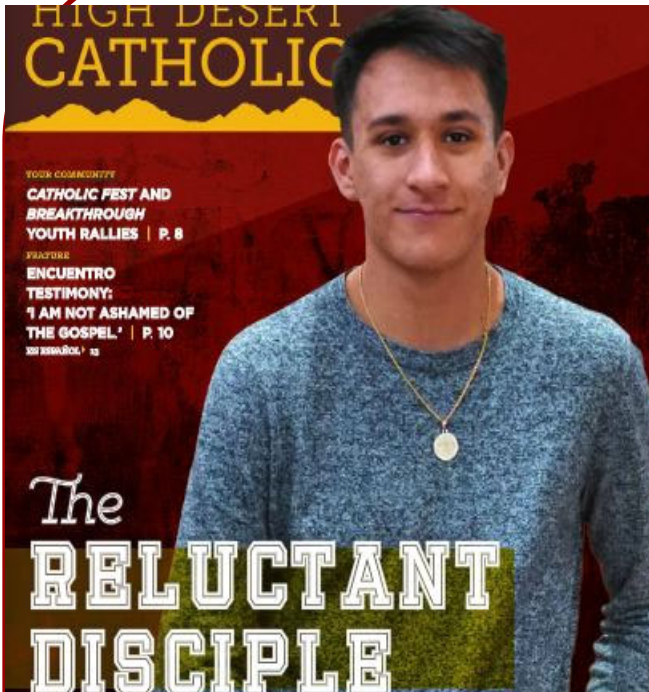

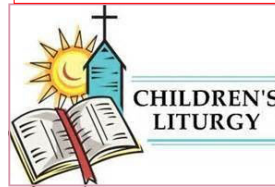

Scrip can be purchased before and after each Mass on the weekends or in the parish office, Monday through Thursday 10 AM to 4 p.m.

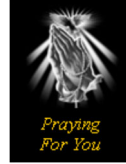

The Mission Co-Op Appeal for 2018 will be held the weekend of July 28 & 29 at all masses. It will be to educate the less fortunate children in Vietnam.



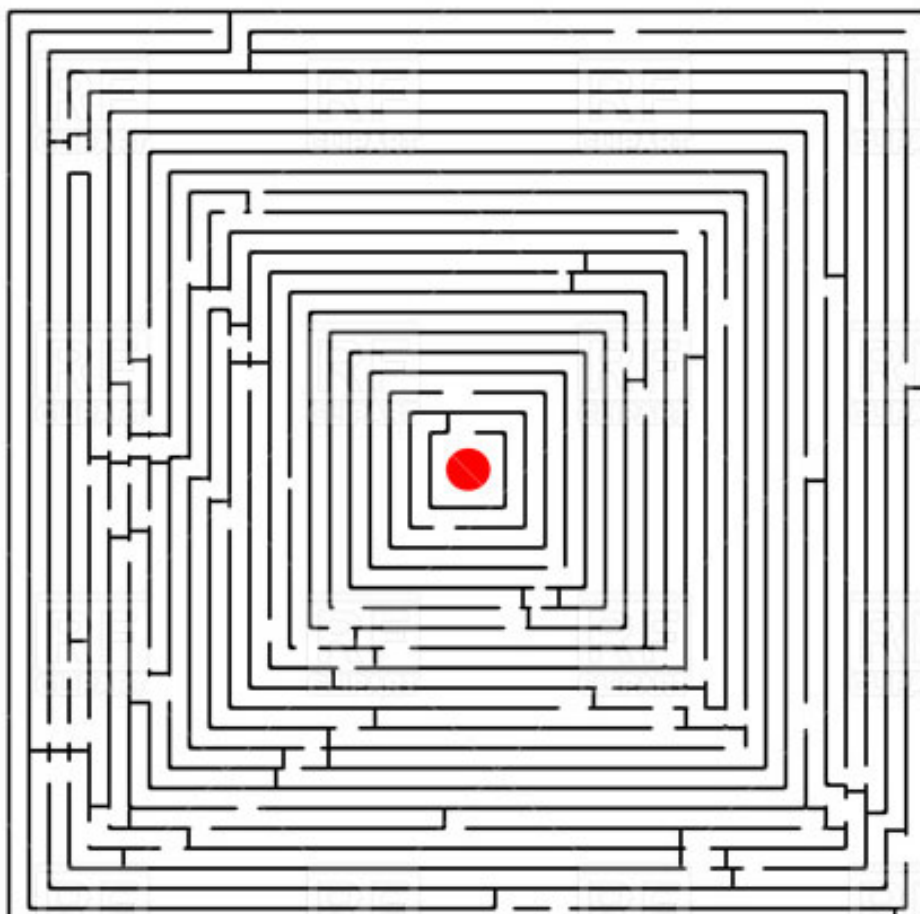
Vacation Bible School! Circus of Stars

SAINTS FUN FACTS

St. Julie of Billiard was born in 1751 in France. As a child she preached the gospel to farm workers to help support her family. Julie and a rich companion founded the Sisters of Notre Dame de Namur. After nursing the wounded and hungry from the Battle of Waterloo, Julie became gravely ill and passed 3 months later in 1816.

She was canonized by Pope Paul VI in 1969.

Issues of Peace and Justice

We presumably celebrate the Trinity always, but today we bring our attention more fully to The Most Holy Trinity. Likewise, Pope Francis' new exhortation, a call to renewed holiness, refers to the Father, Son, and Holy Spirit throughout: "Holiness is ... parrhesía: it is boldness, an impulse to evangelize and to leave a mark in this world. To allow us to do this, Jesus himself comes and tells us once more, serenely yet firmly: 'Do not be afraid.' 'I am with you always, to the end of the world.' These words enable us to go forth and serve with the same courage that the Holy Spirit stirred up in the Apostles, impelling them to proclaim Jesus Christ. Boldness, enthusiasm, the freedom to speak out, apostolic fervor, all these are included in the word parrhesía...Blessed Paul VI, in referring to obstacles to evangelization, spoke of a lack of fervor (parrhesía) that is 'all the more serious because it comes from within.' How often we are tempted to keep close to the shore! Yet the Lord calls us to put out into the deep and let down our nets. He bids us spend our lives in his service. ... May we always feel compelled by his love and say with Saint Paul: 'Woe to me if I do not preach the Gospel.' Look at Jesus. His deep compassion reached out to others. It did not make him hesitant, timid or self-conscious, as often happens with us. Let us acknowledge our weakness, but allow Jesus to lay hold of it and send us too on mission. We are weak, yet we hold a treasure that can enlarge us and make those who receive it better and happier. Boldness and apostolic courage are an essential part of mission. Parrhesía is a seal of the Spirit; it testifies to the authenticity of our preaching. It is a joyful assurance that leads us to glory in the Gospel we proclaim. It is an unshakeable trust in the faithful Witness who gives us the certainty that nothing can 'separate us from the love of God.' We need the Spirit's prompting, lest we be paralyzed by fear and excessive caution, lest we grow used to keeping within safe bounds. Let us remember that closed spaces grow musty and unhealthy. When the Apostles were tempted to let themselves be crippled by danger and threats, they joined in prayer to implore parrhesía: 'And now, Lord, look upon their threats, and grant to your servants to speak your word with all boldness.' As a result, 'when they had prayed, the place in which they



were gathered together was shaken; and they were all filled with the Holy Spirit and spoke the word of God with boldness.' ... **God is eternal newness.** (*Gaudete et Exsultate*, #129-135).

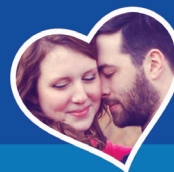

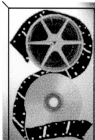
