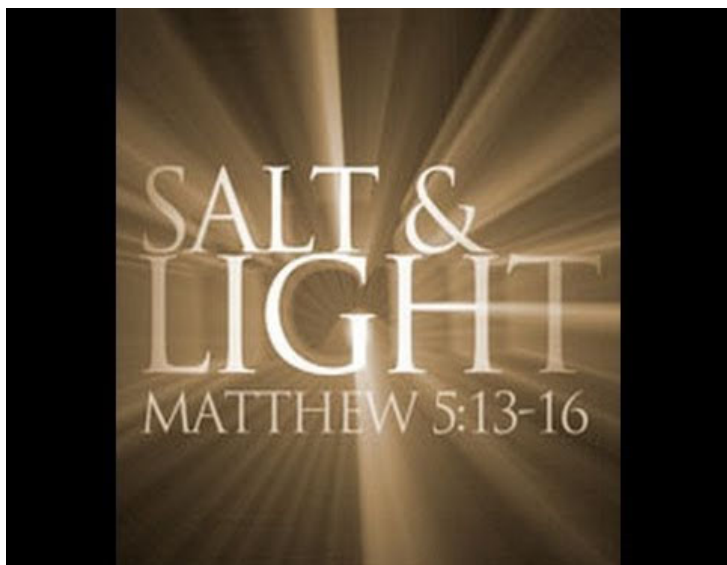

ADMINISTRATION OF THE SACRAMENTS

- **Baptism** • We welcome all families with young children. For your first step, you must become a registered, practicing, contributing member of St. Rose of Lima. Your second step is to contact Susie in the office, 851-1874, to schedule and get a baptism packet. **Be sure you provide all the necessary documents 10 days prior to the baptism class.** Baptism class is the 2nd Thursday of every month at 6 PM. ***Reservations are needed for the class.*** At least one godparent must be a practicing Catholic. All baptisms are celebrated on the 1st, 2nd, 3rd, & 4th Sunday of each month at 12 noon, after the 10:30 Mass. **No baptisms during Lent.**
- **Matrimony** • At least one party must be a registered, practicing member of St. Rose with at least 6 months active proven attendance at Mass. After this is accomplished, please call the office to make an appointment to begin your 6 month marriage preparation process. *Please make no arrangements until after this appointment.* You may pick up a marriage packet in the parish office. *Engaged Encounter* weekend is required: www.renoee.org for dates, times and registration.
- **Anointing of the Sick** • It is best to call at the *beginning* of a serious illness or when surgery is first scheduled.
- ♦ **Funerals** • Upon the death of a loved one, please call the Parish Office to make arrangements, 851-1874.

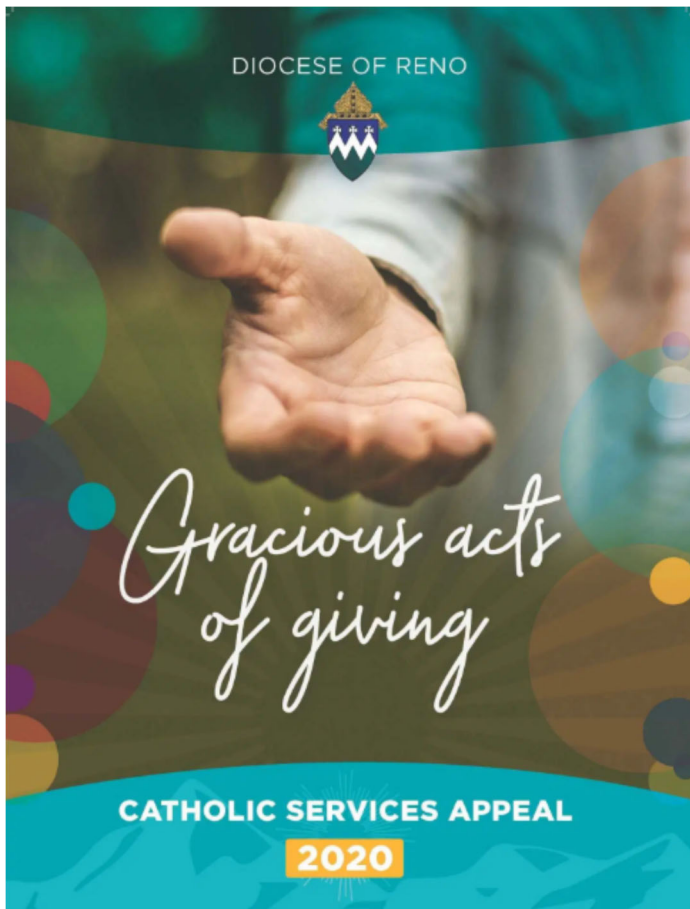

The Trinity (5):**

The *Catechism* summarizes the Trinity in this way: We do not confess three Gods but one God in three persons... The divine persons do not share the one divinity among themselves but each of them is God whole and entire. (CCC 253). The primary scriptural data from which the Church derives the doctrine of the Trinity are:

- that there is only one God (Deuteronomy 6:4);
- that the Father is God (John 5:18);
- that the Son is God (John 8:58); and
- that the Holy Spirit is God (Matthew 28:19).

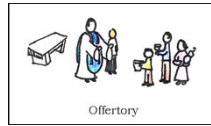
In its simplest outline, the doctrine of the Trinity contains four truths:

In the one divine Nature, there are three Persons, the Father, the Son and the Holy Spirit. No one of the Persons is either of the others, each is wholly Himself.

The Father is God, the Son is God, the Holy Spirit is God.

They are not three Gods but one God.

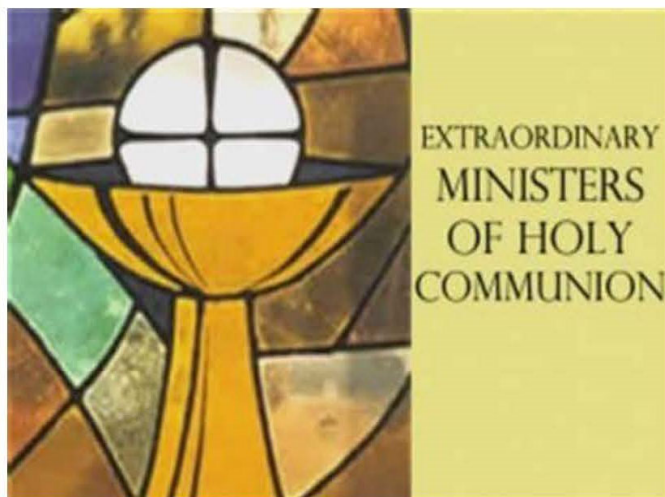
Mass is delayed for your safety. It gives us time to clear the parking lot and sidewalks of snow so no one will slip and fall.

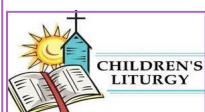


ARE YOU SEARCHING FOR A WAY TO DO GOOD WORKS?

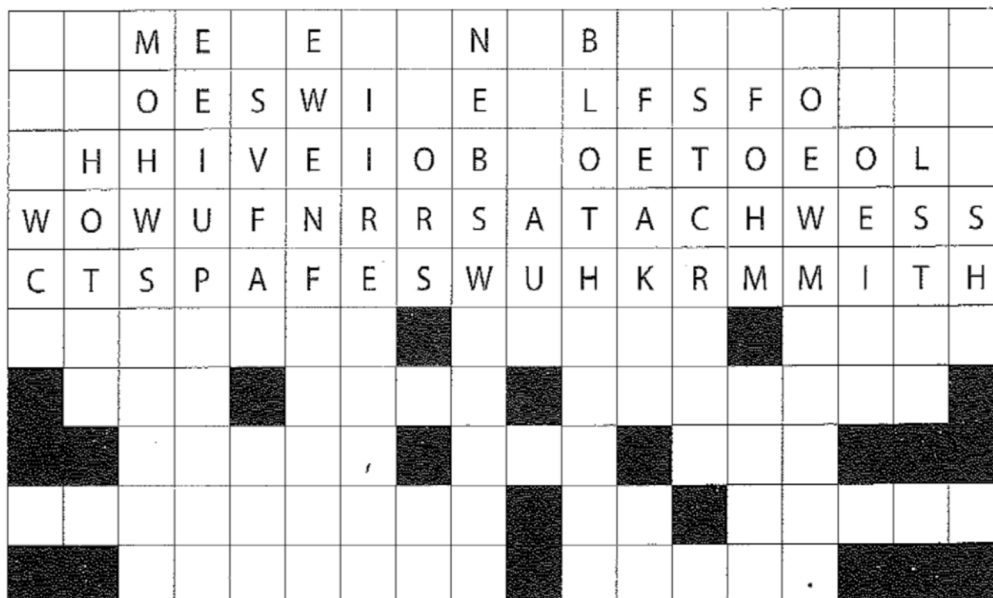

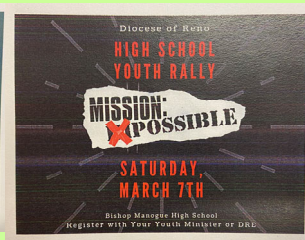

SAINTS FUN FACTS

by John Sheppard

St. Catherine de Ricci was born in Florence in 1522. She entered the convent for Dominicans in Tuscany at fourteen. By the time she was twenty five she became the perpetual prioress.

Her sanctity drew to her side many famous people including 3 Popes. She also corresponded with St. Philip Neri and appeared to him in a miraculous manner. She also experienced the "Ecstasy of the Passion" weekly on Thursdays and Fridays.

She died in 1589 after a long illness.



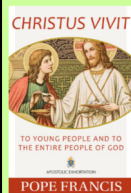
