

MEDITATION OF THE DAY FROM MAGNIFICAT - "The Greatest Sign of Friendship and Love"

This, then, is the last and greatest sign that Our Lord could give.... He who sat at table with the sinners gives himself to be their meat. He at whose table we desire to stand as servants comes forth himself

to serve us. He who lives secretly within the heart, yet who was Incarnate before men's eyes, once more repeats that crowning act of love and presents himself under visible appearances to those eyes that desire to see him. If humility is the essence of friendship, here, surely, is the Supreme Friend....

That he, the Creator of the world, who made himself once to be in the form of a creature; that he who, dwelling in inaccessible light, descended to our lower darkness—that this God of ours, who so passionately desired the friendship of the sons of men as to make himself in their image and likeness—that Jesus Christ, who, rising again from the dead dies now no more (Rom 6:9), who has taken up our human nature to that glory from which that same human nature once brought him down—that he who is above all laws should present himself not once but ten thousand times as our Victim, not once but ten thousand times as our Food...this is indeed the Jesus whom we have known in the Gospels and in our own hearts—our Friend by every right and every claim.

Learn, then, something of his own humility before the Sacrament which is himself. As he strips from himself that glory which is his, we must strip from ourselves the pride to which we have no right—every rag and shred of that complacency and self-centeredness that are the greatest of all obstacles to the designs of his love. We must humble ourselves in the very dust before those divine and gracious feet, which, not only in Jerusalem two thousand years ago, but today and in these cities in which we live, travel so far to seek and save our souls.



PETER'S PENCE - SECOND COLLECTION JUNE 28 & 29, 2025

“The Peter’s Pence collection is a gesture of solidarity through which every member of the faithful can participate in the activity of the Pope as Pastor of the universal Church.

The faithful’s offerings to the Holy Father through the Peter’s Pence Collection are destined to Church needs, to humanitarian initiatives and social promotion projects, as well as to the support of the Holy See.” (USCCB)

ISSUES OF JUSTICE & PEACE

Pope Francis points out in *Laudato Si* that inequality within the human family is more widespread than we often realize. “Inequity affects not only individuals but entire countries; it compels us to consider an ethics of international relations. A true ‘ecological debt’ exists, particularly between the global north and south, connected to commercial imbalances with effects on the environment, and the disproportionate use of natural resources by certain countries over long periods of time. ... The warming caused by huge consumption on the part of some rich countries has repercussions on the poorest areas of the world...” “We note that often the businesses which operate this way are multinationals. They do here what they would never do in developed countries or the so-called first world. Generally, after ceasing their activity and withdrawing, they leave behind great human and environmental liabilities such as unemployment, abandoned towns, the depletion of natural reserves, deforestation, the impoverishment of agriculture and local stock breeding, open pits, riven hills, polluted rivers and a handful of social works which are no longer sustainable.” (#51).



“We must continue to be aware that, regarding climate change, there are differentiated responsibilities. As the United States bishops have said, greater attention must be given to ‘the needs of the poor, the weak and the vulnerable, in a debate often dominated by more powerful interests.’ We need to strengthen the conviction that we are one single human family. There are no frontiers or barriers, political or social, behind which we can hide, still less is there room for the globalization of indifference” (#52).



RELIGIOUS EDUCATION (1st - 5th Grades)

HOLY COMMUNION



- Children typically begin sacramental preparation for First Holy Communion around the age of seven. This preparation, including Reconciliation, spans a two-year period. Students meet weekly with a trained Catechist during the school year and participate in Family Formation.

CONFIRMATION



- Just like the Holy Spirit empowered the disciples at Pentecost, Confirmation brings a special outpouring of the Holy Spirit to strengthen Catholics on their journey of faith. Students typically begin preparation for Confirmation in sixth grade and spans a two-year period. Students in year one meet weekly with a trained Catechist during the school year. Students in year two meet monthly. All groups participate in Family Formation.

OCIA/OCIC



Order of Christian Initiation for Adults/Children

- The Church recognizes that the way to becoming a Christian is not one size fits all. The OCIA offers a basic description of how an unbaptized adult comes to faith and is initiated by the sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation, and Eucharist. It then describes what to do in particular circumstances, including the initiation of children who have reached catechetical age (seven years or older). There is only one rite for everyone who has reached catechetical age; which is then adapted to meet the needs and circumstances for children and families.

✦ YOUTH MINISTRY (6th-12th Grades)

If you have a child who is in high school and seeking Confirmation, and has received Baptism and First Eucharist, please contact Linda at youth@strosereno.com to get on the group list. Registration will open in late June, and you must be a registered parishioner at St. Rose to register your child. Attendance at a parent meeting for families new to our program will be required. We will again follow the family model with monthly classes on Sundays, mass attendance, and twelve hours of family parish activities. Looking forward to another great year! If your child has completed Year One of our Confirmation program, registration for Year Two will also open at the end of June.
