MEDITATION OF THE DAY FROM MAGNIFICAT - "Praying for the Harvest"

The thought which stands out in my mind as an incentive to pray for the missions is that there is not one person created for whom Christ would not have suffered and died, if that one was the only one to be saved. Each one human being is all to

God. The whole of his infinite love is given to each. In this light what a tragedy it is that there can be people who have never heard the name of Christ, and how logical that those who love him find it worth the sacrifice of self to make him known and loved....

The missionary takes more than the knowledge of Christ: he or she takes Christ himself. Priests take Christ in the sacraments. But women take Christ too. To make this clear I will tell you what a priest said to me once, years ago. He had been in a persecuting country and imprisoned. He escaped, but with both his hands cut off. He said "Never again can I lift up Christ in my hands, but I can lift him up in my heart and so can you. You can take Christ everywhere, show him to everyone. Be his monstrance."

The first woman who was Christ's monstrance, who had a missionary heart, was Our Lady. This is why it is natural to pray to her for the missions and for missionaries. When we do so we are not even asking a favor of her, but are only asking her to do what is clearly her own desire. She was, and of course is, compelled by a twofold love, which is the key to her human personality, two loves so inseparable that in her they are one love. The love of God and the love of man.

Her own glorious expression of this love in words is the Magnificat in which Our Lady, rejoicing in the wonder of her motherhood, rejoices most of all, not in her personal delight, but in the fact that her Son will go on his quest of the human heart from generation to generation.

CONGRATULATIONS TO FR. FRANCIS COYNE!

ISSUES OF JUSTICE & PEACE



How do you take this phrase in today’s Gospel, “The kingdom of God is at hand?”

Turning again to the encyclical Laudato Si, we hear more affirmation of humankind. “How wonderful is the certainty that each human life is not adrift in the midst of hopeless chaos, in a world ruled by pure chance or endlessly recurring cycles! We were conceived in the heart of God, and for this reason “each of us is the result of a thought of God. Each of us is willed, each of us is loved, each of us is necessary” (#65). Yet, “the originally harmonious relationship between human beings and nature became conflictual... Today, ...sin is manifest in all its destructive power in wars, the various forms of violence and abuse, the abandonment of the most vulnerable, and attacks on nature (#66). “When all ...relationships [with others, ourselves, God, and the earth] are neglected, when justice no longer dwells in the land, the Bible tells us that life itself is endangered” (#70).

God of love, show us our place in this world as channels of your love for all the creatures of this earth, for not one of them is forgotten in your sight. Enlighten those who possess power and money that they may avoid the sin of indifference, that they may love the common good, advance the weak, and care for this world in which we live. The poor and the earth are crying out. O Lord, seize us with your power and light, help us to protect all life, to prepare for a better future, for the coming of your Kingdom of justice, peace, love and beauty. Praise be to you! Amen. (From A Christian prayer in union with creation, at the end of Laudato Si).

HOLY COMMUNION



- Children typically begin sacramental preparation for First Holy Communion around the age of seven. This preparation, including Reconciliation, spans a two-year period. Students meet weekly with a trained Catechist during the school year and participate in Family Formation.

CONFIRMATION



- Just like the Holy Spirit empowered the disciples at Pentecost, Confirmation brings a special outpouring of the Holy Spirit to strengthen Catholics on their journey of faith. Students typically begin preparation for Confirmation in sixth grade and spans a two-year period. Students in year one meet weekly with a trained Catechist during the school year. Students in year two meet monthly. All groups participate in Family Formation.

OCIA/OCIC




Order of Christian Initiation for Adults/Children

- The Church recognizes that the way to becoming a Christian is not one size fits all. The OCIA offers a basic description of how an unbaptized adult comes to faith and is initiated by the sacraments of Baptism, Confirmation, and Eucharist. It then describes what to do in particular circumstances, including the initiation of children who have reached catechetical age (seven years or older). There is only one rite for everyone who has reached catechetical age; which is then adapted to meet the needs and circumstances for children and families.

YOUTH MINISTRY (6th-12th Grades)

If you have a child who is in high school and seeking Confirmation, and has received Baptism and First Eucharist, please contact Linda at youth@strosereno.com to get on the group list. Registration will open in July, and you must be a registered parishioner at St Rose to register your child. Attendance at a parent meeting for families new to our program will be required. We will again follow the family model with monthly classes on Sundays, mass attendance, and twelve hours of family parish activities. Looking forward to another great year! If your child has completed Year One of our Confirmation program, registration for Year Two is now open.
