## WEEKLY READINGS



### SEVENTEENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME SUNDAY, JULY 27, 2025



#### MEDITATION OF THE DAY FROM MAGNIFICAT - "Teach us to Pray"

When someone speaks to his neighbor, he thinks about what he is saying: and all the more so the more important is the one to whom he is speaking. Therefore, since in praying we speak to the most high God, a man must be most sure to think as he

prays. [According to Saint] Bernard: "When

you enter the church to pray, leave outside the din of your fluctuating thoughts, so that you may be with God alone." For it is not possible that someone should speak to God whilst he is chattering to the whole world, even though he may be in silence....

We are seeking in our prayers that God might be attentive to us, according to the text: Be attentive to me and hear me (Ps 55:3). Now how likely is it that he will do this, if we are not attentive to ourselves?... It is from the heart that prayer takes most of its power.... [According to Saint] Isidore: "Prayer is of the heart, not of the lips." For God does not attend [merely] to the words of the one beseeching him, but he looks rather on the heart of the man who prays. So the man who does not have his heart in his prayer takes away from prayer what is best in it. So it is clear from all this that the heart's intention is necessary in prayer.... So that this may be more easily done, the heart must be first recollected when one comes to pray....

However, it should be known that even when from human weakness someone cannot have his heart firmly in his prayers, he should not for that reason grow weary of praying, since even though a poor man may not be continuously crying out, he nevertheless moves the master of the house to have pity on him simply by his bodily appeal as he sits there at the gate all day long. And much more should one trust in the mercy of our Lord.... When there was a meritorious intention at the beginning of the prayer, the whole work that follows is meritorious, even if one is not always actually thinking about it.

### ISSUES OF JUSTICE & PEACE

One of the common themes found in today's readings is the mercy of God. Is humanity not also called to emulate the mercy of God? In addition, are we not called to recognize the innate dignity of every human person? Under the section in the encyclical Fratelli Tutti, titled “Insufficiently universal human rights,” comes this: “It frequently becomes clear that, in practice, human rights are not equal for all. Respect for those rights ‘is the preliminary condition for a country’s social and economic development. When the dignity of the human person is respected, and his or her rights recognized and guaranteed, creativity and interdependence thrive, and the creativity of the human personality is released through actions that further the common good.’ Yet, ‘by closely observing our contemporary societies, we see numerous contradictions that lead us to wonder whether the equal dignity of all human beings, solemnly proclaimed seventy years ago, is truly recognized, respected, protected and promoted in every situation. In today’s world, many forms of injustice persist, fed by reductive anthropological visions and by a profit-based economic model that does not hesitate to exploit, discard and even kill human beings. While one part of humanity lives in opulence, another part sees its own dignity denied, scorned or trampled upon, and its fundamental rights discarded or violated.’ What does this tell us about the equality of rights grounded in innate human dignity?” (#22) Another question we might ask ourselves: “Who is responsible for promoting the equality of rights grounded in innate human dignity?” The United Nations? A country’s government, Humanitarian groups, such as Catholic Relief Services or Catholic Charities? All of us? Pope Frances again, “Let us be committed to living and teaching the value of respect for others, a love capable of welcoming differences, and the priority of the dignity of every human being over his or her ideas, opinions, practices and even sins” (Fratelli Tutti, On the Fraternity and Social Friendship, #191)




