

EIGHTEENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME SUNDAY, AUGUST 3, 2025



MEDITATION OF THE DAY FROM MAGNIFICAT - "Thanking the Giver of All Good Gifts"

Three good things result from thanksgiving. The first is the preservation of those goods that have already been received.... For it belongs to our good Lord to conserve in a man those things which that man acknowledges that he

holds from him, and on which he pays the tax that is due. And in this case, the tax is thanksgiving, as has been said. The second benefit of thanksgiving is the multiplication of good things. For just as ingratitude prevents this, in accordance with Bernard [of Clairvaux], who says: "Ingratitude is a scorching wind that dries up the spring of love, the dew of mercy, and the waters of grace," so conversely those who give thanks for benefits received are worthy to receive more abundant ones in the present life. And so Bernard says: "From the place whence they came, the rivers of graces return," that is, by thanksgiving, "so that they may flow again." The third benefit is that one obtains greater things in the next life.... Whoever does not glorify the Lord by thanksgiving is...like an untrustworthy servant who holds on to what is his master's. But whoever does glorify him will be advanced to greater things in the future.... Well done, good and faithful servant; I will place thee over many things (Mt 25:23).

Therefore, since so many evils result from ingratitude, and so many good things from thanksgiving, the Church invites us to give thanks, saying daily [in the Preface at Mass]: "It is truly right and just, our duty and our salvation, always and everywhere to give you thanks, Lord, holy Father." And Augustine issues the same invitation, saying: "What better can we keep in our minds or utter with our lips or write with our quills, than: 'Thanks be to God'? Nothing more succinct can be said, nothing more welcome can be heard, nothing greater can be thought, nothing can be more profitably given."... And so, since acting well is a special gift of God, for we can do no good without him, Bernard says: "When you find that you are doing the things which are written, give thanks to our Lord, who is the one who bestows all good things."

ISSUES OF JUSTICE & PEACE

In today’s readings, we hear admonishment about where to place our efforts in this life. St. Paul says bluntly, “Put to death, then, the parts of you that are earthly: immorality, impurity, passion, evil desire, and the greed that is idolatry.... Stop lying to one another.”

Pope Francis, in a corresponding way, offers us a grander focus in life, our human relationships, from our immediate “neighbors” of family and friends and acquaintances, to a global understanding of who our neighbor is. “Today, with our developed spirituality and theology, we have no excuses. Still, there are those who appear to feel encouraged or at least permitted by their faith to support varieties of narrow and violent nationalism, xenophobia and contempt, and even the mistreatment of those who are different. Faith, and the humanism it inspires, must maintain a critical sense in the face of these tendencies, and prompt an immediate response whenever they rear their head. For this reason, it is important that catechesis and preaching speak more directly and clearly about the social meaning of existence, the fraternal dimension of spirituality, our conviction of the inalienable dignity of each person, and our reasons for loving and accepting all our brothers and sisters” (Fratelli Tutti, On the Fraternity and Social Friendship, #86).


