NINETEENTH SUNDAY IN ORDINARY TIME AUGUST 10, 2025



MEDITATION OF THE DAY FROM MAGNIFICAT - "How to Be Ready for the Son of Man"

Lamb of God is how John the Baptist addresses Jesus. From the start, he sees Jesus as a victim, chosen by God himself. The same should and indeed needs to apply to each Christian. We are born to be a living offering, to die with Christ,

and then to share in his glory. We should look forward to the day of our meeting with him as a bride looks forward to her bridegroom. That hour comes for everyone and, what is more, it comes like a thief, at a time in which we are not expecting it. It makes sense, therefore, to live each moment in view of that hour, and to act accordingly....

Certainly, it is good and necessary to work for a better world of tomorrow, which is best done by spreading a Christian lifestyle. And this not least in view of our brothers and sisters who are yet to come, because we want to love them too as Christ has taught us. But as far as we ourselves are concerned, we should always be alert, open to the call to enter into the life to come, into the kingdom which is not of this world.

With God's help I want to be more than just resigned to the fact that one day I need to face my final agony and death. Usually, we look at the ill and the dying as a category apart. We surround them with a special, even supernatural, atmosphere. But shouldn't we try to always live as if today were our last day, our last hour?

Before dying Christ said: Father, glorify your Son (Jn 17:1). In his eyes, it was a beginning therefore, not an ending. And Peter speaks similarly of the crown of glory awaiting us (1 Pt 5:4). This is Christianity. Therefore, I will accept the sufferings that this day will bring me as stepping stones to the final trial, that is, my final agony and struggle. I will look at them as exercises to develop patience, perseverance, trust in God, and a passion for the cross, which ultimately will carry me to glory.



ISSUES OF JUSTICE & PEACE

Faith, one of the three theological virtues, is addressed in all three of today’s readings. Faith is not simply proclaiming, “I believe in God,” either for the ancients or the initial followers of Jesus or those who came later. Faith undergirds one’s life, guides one’s life, affects one’s choices, such as Abraham demonstrated all his life. Jesus tells a parable of faithful servanthood, where one’s actions are ever guided by that faithfulness.

The Compendium of the Social Doctrine of the Church states, “To the people of our time, her traveling companions, the Church also offers her social doctrine. In fact, when the Church ‘fulfills her mission of proclaiming the Gospel, she bears witness to man, in the name of Christ, to his dignity and his vocation to the communion of persons. She teaches him the demands of justice and peace in conformity with divine wisdom.’ This doctrine has its own profound unity, which flows from Faith in a whole and complete salvation, from Hope in a fullness of justice, and from Love which makes all mankind truly brothers and sisters in Christ : it is the expression of God’s love for the world, which he so loved ‘that he gave his only Son.’ The new law of love embraces the entire human family and knows no limits, since the proclamation of the salvation wrought by Christ extends ‘to the ends of the earth’ (Acts 1:8),” (The Compendium of the Social Doctrine of the Church by the Pontifical Council for Justice and Peace, #3).








YOUTH MINISTRY (6th-12th Grade)
