THE CHURCH'S NEWEST CANONIZED SAINTS: CARLO ACUTIS & PIER GIORGIO FRASSATI

On Sunday, September 7, the Church will canonize Carlo Acutis and Pier Giorgio Frassati at St. Peter's Square in Rome. His Holiness Pope Leo XIV will preside. This fulfills the dream of Pope Francis to canonize both young men during the Jubilee Holy Year 2025.



Carlo Acutis (1991 –2006) was born in London, England and raised in Milan, Italy. From an early age, he displayed a remarkable talent for computer programming and a deep love for Christ in the Eucharist. He loved sports, particularly soccer, playing video games,

reading graphic novels, and volunteering with those in need outside of his school hours. With his tech-savvy skills, young Carlo spent four years creating a website that catalogued Eucharistic miracles from around the world. The purpose of his site was to increase awareness and appreciation for the Eucharist while also celebrating the worldwide Church. Tragically, in 2006 when Carlo was just 15, he succumbed to leukemia. Despite this, his story, and website, live on as a shining example of youthful holiness. Recognizing his extraordinary sanctity, the Church beatified Carlo on October 10, 2020, making him the first millennial to be beatified.

Pier Giorgio Frassati (1901-1925) was born in Turin, Italy to a prominent and wealthy family. He was affectionally called the “Man of the Beatitudes” by Pope John Paul II, as he demonstrated his commitment to caring for the poor and sick, helping demobilized servicemen returning from World War I, and giving his bus fare to those in need. He lived his faith through constant, humble, mostly hidden service to the poorest of Turin, never lording over anyone the wealth and prestige of his family. Pier Giorgio had an intense prayer life, spending hours in Eucharistic Adoration and daily praying a rosary on his knees by his bedside. This vibrant young man was also an avid outdoorsman. He loved mountain-climbing, hiking, riding horses, skiing, and sharing jokes with his friends, using these activities to share his faith. In 1922, he joined the Third Order of St. Dominic. In 1925 at the age of 24, he contracted polio, likely from the poor he served so diligently, and passed away just six days later.



ISSUES OF JUSTICE & PEACE

In today's gospel, we hear harsh words from Jesus about one's focus in life. He seems to be telling us to get our priorities straight, priorities that will guide our lives as a whole. "The human person, in himself and in his vocation, transcends the limits of the created universe, of society and of history: his ultimate end is God himself, who has revealed himself to men in order to invite them and receive them into communion with himself. 'Man cannot give himself to a purely human plan for reality, to an abstract ideal or to a false utopia. As a person, he can give himself to another person or to other persons, and ultimately to God, who is the author of his being and who alone can fully accept his gift.' For this reason, 'a man is alienated if he refuses to transcend himself and to live the experience of self-giving and of the formation of an authentic human community oriented towards his final destiny, which is God. A society is alienated if its forms of social organization, production and consumption make it more difficult to offer this gift of self and to establish this solidarity between people,'" (The Compendium of the Social Doctrine of the Church by the Pontifical Council for Justice and Peace, #47).


