MAGNIFICAT'S MEDITATION OF THE DAY

“INCREASE OUR FAITH!”

All the texts of this Sunday's liturgy speak to us of faith, which is the foundation of the whole of Christian life. Jesus taught his disciples to grow in faith, to believe and to entrust themselves increasingly to him, in order to build their own lives on the rock. For this

reason they asked him, increase our faith! What they asked the Lord for is beautiful.... [It is] the grace of faith, which guides and illumines the whole of life; they ask for the grace to recognize God and to be in a close relationship with him, receiving from him all his gifts....

Jesus has recourse to a paradoxical image to express the incredible vitality of faith. Just as a lever raises something far heavier than its own weight, so faith, even a crumb of faith, can do unthinkable, extraordinary things, such as uproot a great tree and plant it in the sea. Faith, trusting in Christ, welcoming him, letting him transform us, following him to the very end, makes humanly impossible things possible.... The Prophet Habakkuk also bears witness to this in the first reading. He implores the Lord, starting with a dreadful situation of violence, iniquity, and oppression. And even in this difficult, insecure situation, the prophet introduces a vision that offers an inside view of the plan that God is outlining and bringing to fulfillment.... The godless person, the one who does not behave in accordance with God, who trusts in his own power and is relying on a frail and inconsistent reality that will therefore give way, is destined to fall; the righteous person, on the other hand, trusts in a hidden but sound reality, he trusts in God and for this reason will have life....

The second part of today's Gospel presents another teaching, a teaching of humility that is nevertheless closely linked to faith....

Jesus makes us aware that, before God, we are in a similar situation: we are God's servants, we are not his creditors but are always indebted to him, because we owe him everything since everything is a gift from him.... We must be aware that in reality we never do enough for God. We must say, as Jesus suggests: We are unworthy servants; we have only done what was our duty. This is an attitude of humility that really puts us in our place and permits the Lord to be very generous to us. In fact, in another Gospel passage, he promises people that he will gird himself and have them sit at table, and he will come and serve them (Lk 12:37).... It will be Jesus himself who serves us, who helps us, who encourages us, who gives us strength and serenity.

ISSUES OF JUSTICE & PEACE

In today's gospel, in answer to his apostles' request to "increase [their]faith," Jesus points out that even after a long day of hard work, there is still more work to be done. Pope St. John Paul II points out some of that work to be done. "Today more than in the past, the Church's social doctrine must be open to an international outlook, in line with the Second Vatican Council [and] the most recent Encyclicals... It will not be superfluous therefore to reexamine and further clarify in this light the characteristic themes and guidelines dealt with by the Magisterium in recent years," (Sollicitudo rei socialis, #42).

A SAINT TO KNOW:

ST. FAUSTINA MARIA KOWALSKA

FEAST DAY: OCTOBER 5TH

St. Faustina (1905-1938) was born Helena Kowalska in Poland to a poor family with ten children. They were devoutly Catholic, and she felt a call to the religious life at age seven, when praying in front of the exposed Eucharist. Despite wanting to become a sister as soon as she finished her schooling, she was sent to work as a housekeeper to help support the family instead.


When she was 18, she had a vision of Jesus suffering and, in the vision, Jesus asked her how long she would keep putting off entering religious life. She decided, at that moment, to travel to Warsaw and join the Congregation of the Sisters of Our Lady of Mercy. Upon entering the Congregation, she took the name Sister Maria Faustina.

During her 13 years in the Congregation, Sister Faustina experienced and recorded extraordinary revelations from Jesus. She recorded these experiences and messages into notebooks which became later known as the *Diary of Saint Maria Faustina Kowalska*. In these writings, she reveals Jesus asking her to proclaim God's loving message of Divine Mercy.

Alongside her writings, Sister Faustina also experienced many miraculous phenomena. There are stories of her experiencing hidden stigmata, bilocation, prophecy, and the ability to read into human souls. Despite these occurrences, she maintained that miraculous events were simply "ornaments" for the soul and that her real sanctity came from her deep relationship with Jesus and desire to do God's will.

After her death at age 33, her writings on Divine Mercy sparked a great movement in the worldwide Catholic church with a strong focus on the Mercy of Christ and how to extend that mercy to others. Saint Pope John Paul II called her "the great apostle of Divine Mercy in our time."


