MAGNIFICAT'S MEDITATION OF THE DAY

“FAITH AND GRATITUDE”

It is not accidental that the ten lepers stood at a distance. On one level, this was simply because the law of Moses required people with skin disease to keep apart from others. But their physical position also seems to suggest a spiritual distance

from Jesus. They are reluctant to come too close to him.

Jesus respected their caution and, without seeking to touch them... he simply sent them to the priests, those authorized to determine whether skin disease has been cleared up. All ten carried out this act of faith.... Somewhere along the way, they found to their amazement that they had in fact been healed! But nine of them simply continued on the way. They showed no particular interest in the one who healed them, no desire to find out who it was who had such life-giving power, not even the common courtesy to thank him.

But one leper turned back—a verb that suggests the turning of conversion. He gave what Scripture often describes as the right human response to God's mighty deeds: loud praise and thanks, publicizing to everyone within earshot the wonderful things the Lord had done for him. I will give thanks to the Lord with my whole heart; I will tell of all your wonderful deeds (Ps 9:1). My lips will shout for joy, when I sing praises to you; my soul also, which you have redeemed (Ps 71:23).

No longer isolated and socially alienated, the healed man has become an evangelist, one who tells others of the wonderful works of God! He is no longer distant from Jesus. He draws near and falls on his face at Jesus' feet—a posture of worship, suggesting that he somehow knows he is in the presence of the Lord, the divine Physician. This man, Luke points out, happens to be a Samaritan. He had therefore been doubly outcast—an unclean leper and a member of a despised people. But now he has been brought into a relationship with Jesus and, by implication, with the disciples who surround him. The shame and loneliness associated with his former condition are gone. His heart is overflowing with gratitude and joy.... He received far more than a physical cure. He experienced a profound healing on every level of his being.

AROUND THE DIOCESE



ISSUES OF JUSTICE & PEACE

In Biblical times and later in history, people with leprosy were segregated, feared, shunned. Yet in today’s gospel, we see Jesus recognizing the humanity in those he encountered. “How many men and women of faith have found mediators of light in those who suffer! So it was with Saint Francis of Assisi and the leper, or with [Saint] Mother Teresa of Calcutta and her poor. They understood the mystery at work in them. In drawing near to the suffering, they were certainly not able to eliminate all their pain or to explain every evil. Faith is not a light which scatters all our darkness, but a lamp which guides our steps in the night and suffices for the journey. To those who suffer, God does not provide arguments which explain everything; rather, his response is that of an accompanying presence, a history of goodness which touches every story of suffering and opens up a ray of light. In Christ, God himself wishes to share this path with us and to offer us his gaze so that we might see the light within it. Christ is the one who, having endured suffering, is ‘the pioneer and perfecter of our faith’ (Heb 12:2). Suffering reminds us that faith’s service to the common good is always one of hope — a hope which looks ever ahead in the knowledge that only from God, from the future which comes from the risen Jesus, can our society find solid and lasting foundations. In this sense faith is linked to hope, for even if our dwelling place here below is wasting away, we have an eternal dwelling place which God has already prepared in Christ, in his body. The dynamic of faith, hope and charity thus leads us to embrace the concerns of all men and women on our journey towards that city ‘whose architect and builder is God (Heb 11:10),’” (Pope Francis’ Lumen Fidei, The light of Faith, #57).


ST. CARLO ACUTIS (1991-2006)

FEAST DAY: OCTOBER 12

From a young age, Carlo had a special love for God, even though his parents weren't especially devout. Antonia Salzano, his mom, said that before Carlo, she went to Mass only for her first Communion, her confirmation, and her wedding. But as a young child, Carlo loved to pray the rosary. After he made his first Communion, he went to Mass as often as possible at the parish across from his elementary school. Carlo's love for the Eucharist also inspired a deep conversion for his mother. According to the postulator promoting his cause for sainthood, he "managed to drag his relatives, his parents to Mass every day. It was not the other way around; it was not his parents bringing the little boy to Mass, but it was he who managed to get himself to Mass and to convince others to receive Communion daily." Salzano spoke to "EWTN News Nightly" in October 2023 about her son's devotion to the Blessed Sacrament. She said: "He used to say, 'There are queues in front of a concert, in front of a football match, but I don't see these queues in front of the Blessed Sacrament' ... So, for him the Eucharist was the center of his life."

"The more Eucharist we receive, the more we will become like Jesus, so that on earth we will have a foretaste of heaven."
