### MAGNIFICAT'S MEDITATION OF THE DAY "PRAY ALWAYS"

Saint Alphonsus Liguori relates that Saint Teresa would have wished to ascend to the top of a high mountain, and be able to make her voice heard by the whole world, for the sole purpose of crying out to it: "Pray, pray, pray." She

had rightly understood the words Our Lord addresses to each of us: We ought always to pray and not to faint (Lk 18:1).

In the spiritual life there are two great principles which should never be forgotten: Without grace we can do nothing; with it we can do all things. Sometimes it anticipates our desires; ordinarily, God waits till we ask for it. This is a general law thus expressed by Our Lord: Ask, and it shall be given to you. Prayer is, therefore, not only a precept, it is a necessity. God places the treasure of his graces at our disposal, and its key is prayer. You desire more faith, more hope, more love: Ask, and it shall be given to you. Your good resolutions remain sterile, resulting always in the same failures: Ask, and it shall be given to you. Precepts are numerous, virtue painful, temptation seductive, the enemy ruthless, the will weak: Ask, and it shall be given to you. Prayer will draw down into your soul the omnipotence of God....

"But I pray and I do not obtain." It is because you ask amiss. "I have been asking now for a long time." Ask again, seek, knock; reanimate your desires, importune heaven, make the voice of your soul loud and shrill as a piercing cry.... The Master of grace, Truth itself, has [given us] a promise supremely encouraging. The only reproach he makes us is that we do not ask enough.

## **AROUND THE DIOCESE**

### **ISSUES OF JUSTICE & PEACE**

All of today's readings address the weariness than can be experienced in faithfully persisting in following God's will. St. Paul says clearly, "Be persistent whether it is convenient or inconvenient."

"The inner transformation of the human person, in his being progressively conformed to Christ, is the necessary prerequisite for a real transformation of his relationships with others. 'It is necessary, then, to appeal to the spiritual and moral capacities of the human person and to the permanent need for his inner conversion, so as to obtain social changes that will really serve him. The acknowledged priority of the conversion of heart in no way eliminates but, on the contrary, imposes the obligation of bringing the appropriate remedies to institutions and living conditions when they are an inducement to sin, so that they conform to the norms of justice and advance the good rather than hinder it.'"



It is not possible to love one's neighbor as oneself and to persevere in this conduct without the firm and constant determination to work for the good of all people and of each person, because we are all really responsible for everyone. According to the Council's teaching, 'they also have a claim on our respect and charity that think and act differently from us in social, political and religious matters. In fact the more deeply we come to understand their ways of thinking through kindness and love, the more easily will we be able to enter into dialogue with them.' This path requires grace, which God offers to man in order to help him to overcome failings...(The Compendium of the Social Doctrine of the Church by the Pontifical Council for Justice and Peace, #42 & #43).



### A SAINT TO KNOW:

**ST. JOHN PAUL II (1920-2005)**

**FEAST DAY: OCTOBER 22**


Pope St. John Paul II, born Karol Wojtyla, was elected pope in 1978, the first non-Italian pope in over 400 years. Throughout his life, he was known for his love of young people, often taking groups on hiking and skiing trips that involved Mass and theological discussions. Pope John Paul II went out to the entire world with a vigorous missionary spirit. He embarked on 104 apostolic journeys to 129 different countries, “to the uttermost parts of the earth” (Acts 13:47), beginning with the West, Mexico and the United States, for the sake of the Gospel. His love for young people led him to establish World Youth Day, celebrated 19 times during his pontificate, which attracted millions of young people from all over the world. The Pope’s concern for marriage and the family was clearly expressed in the establishment of the World Meeting of Families, his Wednesday catechesis on human love and the founding of the Pontifical John Paul II Institute for Studies on Marriage and Family. He retained his Episcopal motto, drawn from the profound insight of St. Louis de Montfort, “Totus Tuus – I am completely yours.” It would become increasingly clear to the world that this papacy was an incarnation of that motto and a direct response to Divine Love, which was profoundly expressed in his love for man.


