MAGNIFICAT'S MEDITATION OF THE DAY "TRUE AND SAVING WORSHIP"

All repetitive forms of expression run the risk of becoming automatic, lifeless habits; yet this does not prevent longing to hear certain words repeated over and over again. Even if this action itself has become mere habit, the failure to perform it is sometimes far more significant; it usually reveals a rejection of love. By analogy, to avoid seeking God's presence in church on his chosen day is to refuse to bring to reality the bond of love; it is to turn away from God to the pursuit of a life divorced from his sacramental presence. If going to Mass has become boring to some, it is not usually because of the formal structures, but because Christ in the Mass seems unreal to them. A person who no longer truly believes that Christ is present in the Mass is likely to focus on exterior aspects of Church rites instead of on essentials. His mood is like that of a man who is so disappointed in his blind date that his mind wanders from her to the question of how to spend the least money, or who else in the room might be more interesting....

In every loving relationship there are certain moments the memory of which are cherished and often celebrated as anniversaries. So, in a similar way, the liturgy of the Church celebrates the great moments of God's love for man: the birth of Christ; the Crucifixion; the Resurrection; the coming of the Holy Spirit. Each Mass serves to express in its liturgy the basic rhythm of human and divine love. We begin with the acknowledgment of the rift between ourselves and Christ, caused by our turning away from him...: "Lord, have mercy." We remind ourselves of the beauty of God, our great Love: "Glory to God in the highest." We listen to what he has to say to us: the readings from Sacred Scripture. We renew our act of faithful commitment to him: the Creed. We offer ourselves to him—not just the attractive part but the whole of our daily lives—and we beg him to renew his redemption of us. Then, Christ takes the lead. We watch in wonder as he again shoulders our sins, renews his sacrifice, reconciles us to each other in peace, gives himself to us in Holy Communion, sealing us to him and to each other through the mystical participation in his Body and Blood. Transformed by Christ and filled with his strength, we go forth to bring him to the world in which we live.

- Prepare prayerfully** for the Holy Mass
- Focus your heart and mind** on the presence of God
- Offer personal intentions and thanksgivings** to the Lord
- Enter more fully** into the celebration of the Paschal Mystery

We encourage you to arrive early, settle into quiet reflection, and allow this silence to deepen your encounter with Christ in the Word and the Eucharist.

AROUND THE DIOCESE

ISSUES OF JUSTICE & PEACE

Today's gospel is, perhaps, a warning to many of us good church goers. At first glance, we might be inclined to say, "Of course I am not like the Pharisee!"

With a second glance, we might wonder, "Really, what did the Pharisee do or say that was so bad?" And, hopefully, with the third glance, we will see what we are called to, humility. "It is true that in our dealings with the world, we are told to give reasons for our hope, but not as an enemy who critiques and condemns.

We are told quite clearly: 'do so with gentleness and reverence' (1 Pet 3:15) and 'if possible, so far as it depends upon you, live peaceably with all' (Rom 12:18). We are also told to overcome 'evil with good' (Rom 12:21) and to 'work for the good of all' (Gal 6:10). Far from trying to appear better than others, we should 'in humility count others better' than ourselves (Phil 2:3). The Lord's apostles themselves enjoyed 'favor with all the people' (Acts 2:47; 4:21, 33; 5:13). Clearly Jesus does not want us to be grandees who look down upon others, but men and women of the people. This is not an idea of the Pope, or one pastoral option among others; they are injunctions contained in the word of God which are so clear, direct and convincing that they need no interpretations which might diminish their power to challenge us. Let us live them sine glossa, without commentaries. By so doing we will know the missionary joy of sharing life with God's faithful people as we strive to light a fire in the heart of the world," (Evangelii Gaudium, The Joy of the Gospel, #271).

THE CHURCH'S SEVEN NEW SAINTS

On Sunday, October 19th, in Saint Peter's Square, Pope Leo XIV presided over the Eucharistic celebration with the rite of canonization of seven new saints of the Catholic Church.

Ignatius Maloyan, Peter To Rot, Vincent Maria Poloni, María Carmen Rendiles Martínez, Maria Troncatti, José Gregorio Hernández Cisneros, and Bartolo Longo were elevated to sainthood.

“Today we have before us seven witnesses, the new Saints, who, with God's grace, kept the lamp of faith burning,” he said. “Indeed, they themselves became lamps capable of spreading the light of Christ.”

The Pope said the great “material, cultural, scientific, and artistic treasures” of our world are not to be undervalued, but noted that their true meaning is lost without faith.


A world without faith, added the Pope, would be filled with children without a Father, who would have no desire for life since there would be no hope left in their hearts for salvation.

For this reason, Jesus invites us to pray always, so that our bond of love with God may be sustained and our hearts may welcome His salvation.

“Just as breathing sustains the life of the body, so prayer sustains the life of the soul,” he said. “Faith, in fact, is expressed in prayer, and authentic prayer lives on faith.”


Pope Leo XIV noted that Christians often face two temptations when we pray. One temptation is to let the scandal of evil overcome us and lead us to think that God does not care for our plight. At other times, we are tempted to treat prayer as a command to God, as we seek to make Him act justly according to our interpretation of reality.




