Dear Parish Family,

I am pleased to provide an update to my October letter, detailing our response to the *2025 Voices Shaping the Future* Parish Survey and the latest update to our **Capital Campaign – Shaping the Future**. The volunteer Committees that were formed to respond to the survey have provided outstanding ideas. We will soon be communicating their ideas that will nourish both your spiritual needs and build upon our already vibrant Parish Community.

The Capital Campaign Committee has been formed to ensure we adequately fund the projects to meet the physical needs of our Parish. A Comprehensive Capital Needs Plan includes those initiatives listed in my initial letter to you in mid-March 2025 and the needs identified in the survey. This comprehensive list is detailed on the next page.

Once again, I ask for your generosity and prayers as we begin our **Capital Campaign- Shaping the Future**. My personal prayer as your Pastor is to have a donation from each family and registered person in our parish. No donation is too small. We will offer options including one-time donations, 3-year pledges and monthly donations to fit parishioners' preferences.

Over the coming months, we will be hosting estate planning and financial planning seminars lead by experts who are members of our Parish. These seminars will provide our parishioners with valuable information that may include bequests, endowments, qualified charitable distributions, and annual tax-advantaged donations.

In the March letter we identified certain initiatives for the St. Rose of Lima Church, estimated at \$8.5M, and asked for your support. As a result of your tremendous generosity, some of these items have already been funded and completed or are in the process of completion. These include:

- **Landscaping:** You may have noticed some of the lovely improvements made this year. Opportunities to sponsor the ongoing maintenance of the 11 planters located around our Church in the name of a loved one or your family will be available to you.
- **Security System:** Improvements have been installed in the church and in the Flocchini Education Center.
- **Sound System:** Enhancements are being undertaken to improve the quality of the sound for all parishioners.
- **Parking Lot:** The patching will delay repaving for several more years.

The revised capital funding requirement is now **\$5,186,500** over the next 3 years.

I invite you to prayerfully consider your personal donation to this **Capital Campaign-Shaping the Future**. Remember, no donation is too small. Members of our Capital Campaign will be contacting you to share details of the donation options and to answer any questions.

Capital Campaign - Shaping the Future List of Capital Projects

Project	Funding Needed	Projected Date
Parking Lot Repairs - Repaving cost is listed. Patching and crack repair have already been completed and is projected to last until 2028.	\$1,000,000	June 2029 - June 2030
Replace Light Fixtures - Due to shortage of replacement bulbs, project will be necessary in 2027.	\$200,000	Jun 2027
Kitchen Remodel - Critically needed and will proceed ASAP. Czyz's Appliance has donated most of the new appliances/fixtures. Knights of Columbus and other parishioners have made significant donations to the project.	\$500,000	Jun 30, 2026
Pipe Organ - Significant donations from individuals will defray a portion of the expense. Installation will place the organ in the back corner of the Choir area with pipes installed high on the back walls above the choir and Mt Rose mosaic.	\$650,000	Dec 2026
Rectory Repairs - Consists of cleaning and necessary repairs to sell property.	\$10,000	May 2026
New Rectory - The Diocese stipulates specific privacy requirements that are not met by the current rectory. The rectory also is required to house up to 4 priests/seminarians, the current location only allows for 2. The cost shown includes new furniture (replacing 20+ year old items) and landscaping. The net costs reflects the expected funds from the sale of the existing rectory.	\$1,650,000	Jun 2026
Repainting the Church - This project includes painting both the interior and exterior of the Church (not completed since the church was opened in 2003)	\$500,000	June 2028 - June 2029
Total Capital Projects	\$4,510,000	
Contingency Factor (15%) - We have factored in an increase in the costs for projects so that the parish would not have to raise additional funds at the end of 2028.	\$676,500


