Second Collection

Dear Sisters and Brothers in Christ,

As we prepare to support The Catholic Relief Services Collection, let us unite in our mission of love and compassion. Your generous contributions to this collection provide emergency assistance to victims of war and natural disasters, as well as crucial support for migrants and refugees in need of housing, education, and legal aid. It also extends pastoral care to travelers and those who require spiritual support to access the sacraments.

Among the most vulnerable are victims of human trafficking. Millions of men, women, and children worldwide are coerced into commercial sex activities, labor, and slavery—atrocities that our Holy Father has condemned as "a crime against humanity". The Church is called to combat this grave injustice and bring comfort and healing to its victims, proclaiming Christ's salvation and restoring the dignity of all persons.

With funds received through The Catholic Relief Services Collection, the office of Migration and Refugee Services (MRS) of the United States Conference of Catholic Bishops launched a pilot program to combat human trafficking among indigenous Hawaiians in the Diocese of Honolulu and on the St. Regis Mohawk Reservation in the Diocese of Ogdensburg, New York. Working with local partners, MRS staff assessed the challenges facing those communities, trained local leaders to recognize the signs of human trafficking, and helped leaders establish networks to respond to the needs of victims.

The invaluable work supported by The Catholic Relief Services Collection enables MRS and five other Catholic ministries to reveal Christ's love to victims of trafficking, war, and natural disasters both around the world and here in the United States. I ask you to prayerfully consider how you can support the collection this year.


