

A Note from Fr. Sengole

All generations will call me blessed, exclaimed Mary!

Very early on I developed my devotion to our Blessed Mother. As a young boy, I was part of a pilgrimage to the National Shrine of Our Lady of Veilankanni at Veilankanni, Tamilnadu, India. I was awestruck to see the crowds thronging the shrine every day. The variety of pius activities and the Holy Mass celebrated in many languages simply filled me with more devotion to the Blessed Mother.

The month of August has three Marian memorials. On the 5th we celebrated the memorial of the dedication of the first basilica in the West of Saint Mary Major in Rome in the year 434. On the 22nd, we celebrate Mary Queen of Heaven. This week, we will be celebrating the solemnity of the Assumption of Our Lady.

This is a profound mystery of our faith. How wonderful to know that Our Lady is in Heaven, ceaselessly interceding for all of us to get there! How magnificent it is to realize that God's mother is our mother as well! She is Mother of Christ, our brother, and she is the Mother of God because Our Lord is the second person in the Trinity! She is the Mother of the Church, because we as the Church are the Body of Christ. She was with the Apostles during those early days praying and imploring the gifts of the Spirit for all of us. Moreover, she is the "preeminent and wholly unique member of the Church in such a way that she is the "exemplary realization" [typus] of the Church (Lumen Gentium 53 & 63).

When her earthly life was finished, Mary was taken up body and soul, that is assumed into heaven, while Jesus ascended into heaven from where He came down in order to save us. Mary's assumption is to affirm her being fully conformed to her Son, "The Assumption of the Blessed Virgin is a singular participation in her Son's Resurrection and an anticipation of the resurrection of other Christians" (CCC 966). What we hope to realize after our death, we see in Mary's life. How realistic and beautiful is our hope of our life in Heaven! Our belief in after-life and life in Heaven is not simply some nice words, it is the most sublime truth! Mary reached there! That is what we celebrate on Assumption Day! Mary's only job in Heaven is to intercede for bringing us to her, as we are here to bring one another to Heaven that is discipleship! Let us remember that Mary is honored in the Church primarily because of her singular discipleship to our Lord.
