



Stewardship Reflection: When will I have given enough - of my income, of my time, of my talents? Today's Gospel suggests that only *total stewardship* will do: "When you have done all you have been commanded to do, say 'We are useless servants. We have done no more than our duty.'"

Our Mission Statement

As committed Christians of the Roman Catholic Church in Richmond, Indiana, we are a community, centered in Christ, rooted in the Eucharistic communion, journeying together in our call to be holy, constantly discerning the charisms of the Spirit, making one another disciples of Christ and seeking God's kingdom in service, stewardship and charity.



Why do we need the Holy Spirit to live courageously?

"Before Pentecost, no one — with the possible exception of Mary, the mother of Jesus—possessed the courage to stand up against the powers of darkness that were responsible for the Lord's passion and death. After Pentecost, the fearful, tongue-tied disciples were reborn. These were the same men and women, with the same faults and personal weaknesses, but their manner was radically different. The power of the Holy Spirit transformed the disciples... into fearless public witnesses to His resurrection and ascension."

A note from Fr. Sengole

On March 25, 2019, Pope Francis issued a letter entitled *Christus vivit (Christ is Alive)*; it is a Post-synodal apostolic exhortation to young people and to the entire people of God. It is a remarkable letter through which the Holy Father addresses the youth and invites them to start initiating a relationship with Jesus. Throughout this letter, the Holy Father alludes to the many different young people who responded to God in many different historical events both biblical and in the history of the Church. Beginning from the young Joseph to the young girl Ruth in the Old Testament, and the real young people who encountered Jesus and the young characters he created in His parables in the New Testament, the Pope's letter summarizes the place of young people in the Bible. He speaks about our Lord as a young man who revolutionized the world by witnessing to God's love, followed by Mary and the many young saints who shine like stars in the Church. Then, the pope asks how relevant and how friendly is the Church to the young people? In various ways the Church can be relevant and remain friendly in nurturing a true spirituality for the youth. Talking about the digital environment, he says, "it is true that the digital world can expose you to the risk of self-absorption, isolation and empty pleasure. But don't forget that there are young people even there who show creativity and even genius. That was the case with the Venerable Carlo Acutis" (CV 104).

What kind of youth ministry should a parish envision to the young people? The pope delineates that every parish should, first of all, offer opportunities for authentic worship of God in Christ. In his own words, "I wish simply to emphasize that youth ministry involves two main courses of action. One is outreach, the way we attract new young people to an experience of the Lord. The other is growth, the way we help those who have already had that experience to mature in it" (CV 209). The three truths our young people should know about our faith, according to this letter: 1) "God loves you" 2) that Christ, out of love, sacrificed himself completely in order to save you and 3) Christ is not a fine model from the distant past, Christ is alive!

I know that our parish youth ministry needed to be halted, for want of a better term! After being here in the parish for three months, I strongly feel that we should keep our parish youth ministry revived. A youth minister for our parish is a pressing need! With your generous help and commitment, this is possible. Again, everything that we do is an attempt to realize our parish mission statement. What better work can we do to our young people than bringing to be touched by the merciful love of God in Christ?

This is a direct result of ineffective evangelization and a lack of discipleship. We want to help parishes raise up young adult communities of missionary disciples who are characterized by what Pope Francis called a "missionary impulse" or a deep ache to spread the Good News."

Marriage as a Sacrament

A marriage is brought into being by the lawfully manifested consent of persons who are legally capable. This consent cannot be supplied by any human power.
Canon 1057.1

Matrimonial consent is an act of will by which a man and a woman by an irrevocable covenant mutually give and accept one another for the purpose of establishing a marriage.
Canon 1057.2

All can contract marriage who are not prohibited by law. Canon 1058

The marriage of Catholics, even if only one party is baptized, is governed not only by divine law but also by canon law, without prejudice to the competence of the civil authority in respect of the merely civil effects of the marriage.
Canon 1059

Picture/Video

At most weddings, a photographer, and perhaps videographer, is hired to provide a pictorial record. We understand that this record is important but it is essential that the focus of those participating in this liturgy be the liturgy itself - not the person taking pictures! So, we ask that no photographer/videographer be in or around the sanctuary area while the liturgy is taking place. Please share this information with your photographer.

Other Guidelines

Hall & Church facilities: You are welcome to use parish halls/gymnasium for preparation, rehearsal dinner and reception. A rental fee for rehearsal and reception will apply, with parties providing proof of insurance. You are responsible to clean up after the event. Contact the parish secretary.

No alcohol may be brought to, or consumed on, any of the parish grounds or parking lots. This is especially important on the day of your wedding, because alcohol consumption may be used as just cause to nullify your marriage. Violators will be asked to leave the church grounds immediately.

Marriage Preparation Elsewhere

You may just use one of our church campuses for your wedding though you do your preparation in another Catholic parish. You may also choose your priest or deacon to preside at your wedding. All documents for such preparation must be provided to the pastor in due time.

Fees & Honorarium: The church fee for weddings is \$ 500. This fee is to be paid to reserve the church and your date of wedding. Couples are encouraged to pay a separate honorarium to the organist, wedding coordinator and the priest in appreciation for their help in preparing for your wedding. We encourage you to take care of this.

WEDDING GUIDELINES

Congratulations! You are getting married! One of the most important and exciting milestones in a person's life is getting married. Becoming engaged sets into motion many events and lots of planning, not the least of which is arranging for the wedding ceremony itself.

Marriage is a lifelong commitment. No other decision you make may be as important as this one. We are not just helping you prepare for your wedding day; our primary focus is preparing you for your married life.

This involves:

- Preparing for a church wedding and a lifetime of Christian marriage as Sacrament.
- Planning a church wedding at one of our campuses: St. Mary, St. Andrew or Holy Family
- Taking a FOCCUS inventory score to facilitate open communication between the couple.

The marriage covenant, by which a man and a woman establish between themselves a partnership of their whole life, and which of its own very nature is ordered to the well-being of the spouses and to the procreation and upbringing of children, has, between the baptized, been raised by Christ the Lord to the dignity of a sacrament.

Canon 1055.1

Meeting with the priest

At least six months prior to their desired wedding date the couple meets with Fr. Sengole Gnanaraj. At this meeting forms required for marriage in the church are filled out; the priest explains and answers questions about the entire preparation process. Additional meetings may be required.

Reserving a Date & Time for your Wedding

There are certain times when, because of archdiocesan liturgical guidelines we do not schedule weddings. They are: *Season of Advent, Season of Lent, First Communion Weekend, and Parish Picnic Weekend*. During your first meeting with the priest, reserve the Date and Time and get it confirmed by the priest. Weddings can be scheduled on Friday evenings or Saturday afternoon no later than 1.30pm. The church will be available for decoration on the wedding day at 8.30am. If on a Saturday, the celebration shall end by 4pm making it easier for the Sunday anticipation Mass.

Wedding Party: You will need at least two persons, usually 1 male & 1 female to serve as your witnesses. You may have children serve as ring bearers or flower girls. Please advise your friends/wedding party not to chew gum or bring beverages to Church.

FOCCUS – Couple Inventory

FOCCUS (Facilitating Open Couple Communication, Understanding and Study) is a self-diagnostic inventory designed to help couples learn more about themselves and their unique relationship. It is a tool to help couples name and work through issues. At the first meeting with the priest, along with other pre-nuptial document preparation, the FOCCUS couple inventory is administered. The priest will guide the process. This lasts about 45 minutes. Then later, the results of this test will be discussed and facilitated by a FOCCUS trained facilitator. A fee of \$25 is to be paid for the online test scoring and related materials. The couple inventory will be administered at the first meeting with the priest.

Marrying a Non-Catholic?

As a baptized Catholic you are obligated to marry in the Church. But if your future spouse is a non-Catholic the issue of choosing a faith in which to rear your children can be a sensitive one, which merits full, frank and charitable

The essential properties of marriage are unity and indissolubility; in Christian marriage they acquire a distinctive firmness by reason of the sacrament.

Canon 1056

discussion between the engaged couples. For this reason, the law of the Church requires that the Catholic party sign a promise to do everything possible [while respecting the rights of his/her future spouse] to have the children of the marriage baptized and raised as Catholics. The non-Catholic party needs to be aware of this promise. No such promise is asked of the non-Catholic party. A letter of permission for such marriage is granted by the Archbishop.

Catholic Engaged Encounter/Pre-Cana/TOBIT

At least three months prior to your desired wedding date you are encouraged to attend one of these retreats. The parish will provide information on when and where the retreats are held and an application form. Couples are responsible for the cost of the retreat. If you are experiencing financial hardship, convey it to the priest. The certificate of completion for the retreat is to be presented to Fr. Sengole Gnanaraj.

Sponsor Couple

Sponsor couples play a vital role in the preparation of a wedding. The sponsor couples usually go over the FOCCUS results, helping you navigate your conversation. They are couples that are great witnesses to their own marriage life. They will share with you their views, convictions and life lessons gotten from their own marriage. You will be asked to contact the sponsor couples after being assigned. If you know a sponsor couple you are comfortable with, let the priest know of it.

Liturgical Selection Record:

In order to prepare for a meaningful liturgy of the celebration of your marriage as a sacrament (Mass or without Mass), at least 3 weeks prior to your marriage, meet with the priest to select readings, music and other arrangements to better coordinate the liturgy.

Rehearsal: The previous day to the wedding is the rehearsal day, no later than 6:00 pm.

Music: The pastor must approve the music you choose.
