Do I believe in the Resurrection of the Dead?

“I believe in the resurrection of the dead.” I have prayed those words an uncountable number of times, during the Mass, at the beginning of rosaries, in religious education. It appeared, however, that I never actually paid attention to the words I was praying, because when a Protestant member of my high school Bible club mentioned a future where our souls will be reunited to our bodies, all I could think was, “Do Catholics believe that?”

We do. In fact, it’s a very important aspect of our faith, so much so that we repeat it at Mass every week. The truth of the matter is that there is a common misconception about eternal life that neglects and undermines the amazing truth and hope found in the resurrection of the dead. The misconception I am speaking of is the idea that our final destination as Christians is an eternity in an ephemeral, cloud-based heaven, where our souls sail about unencumbered by our bodies and basking in the spiritual glory of God. The Church tells us that this image is simply not the case. Our eternity isn’t to be spent in a perpetual, out-of-body experience.

To understand this teaching, let’s backtrack to the account of the resurrection of Christ. That Christ gave himself on Good Friday to save us from our sin is made known through the Gospels; meanwhile, tradition tells of how Christ descended into hell and liberated the newly sanctified souls, leading them to heaven. And then the story continues. Christ rises from the dead, and in so doing manifests our destiny to be ourselves raised from the dead.

Remember, of course, that God isn’t just going to plop us in a copy of our current bodies. Instead, our rising from the dead will be a rising unto glorified bodies. Christ illuminates this truth for us as well. Remember how Mary Magdalene didn’t recognize Jesus? How the two disciples on the way to Emmaus couldn’t either? It’s not merely that they were dumb or blind or Jesus thought it would be fun to wear a disguise. Rather, His disciples couldn’t recognize him because Christ had revealed himself in his glorified body. It was different; it was perfected; it was the human

body supernaturally perfected and free from death. It was Jesus, risen from the dead, but somehow unrecognizable as glorified. In his resurrection appearances, Christ revealed not only his new glorified life but also our future with him — life eternal, with a glorified body and soul, living on the face of a renewed earth.

By being raised bodily from the dead, we will be fully united, body and soul, with God. This truth is described in the Catechism: “At the end of time, the Kingdom of God will come in its fullness. After the universal judgment, the righteous will reign for ever with Christ, glorified in body and soul. The universe itself will be renewed.”

Though this may seem like a small, silly distinction, eternity embodied or not, it really is a significant tenet of the Christian faith. *Lumen Gentium* states that the Church “will receive her perfection only in the glory of heaven, when will come the time of the renewal of all things.” This line describes the perfection of the Church, and all her members, as being wholly fulfilled only at this renewal of all things which we call the creation of a new earth. Until then, the Church awaits her full perfection.

Our perfection after death, therefore, comes not as mere souls divorced from our bodies, but as new creations. At the end of time, we will live fully in God’s presence, but will do so bodily as well as spiritually. We will retain our nature as children of Adam and Eve, who were made to walk in the garden with God. But we will be glorified in body and soul, as the Incarnate Word himself after his resurrection. This truth is an important one to contemplate because it strengthens our hope by reminding us that we are made for more than this world, and that we are made for more than an ephemeral concept of “heaven.” We are made for life with the Risen Christ, sharing a life like his, in a renewed creation he is preparing for us right now.”

ANUNCIOS PARA LA COMUNIDAD LATINA

Mensaje por el Padre Sengole Gnanaraj

¿Quién es Jesús para tí? Esta es una pregunta que nos hace pensar mucho! Con el propósito de apropiarnos del Kerygma (proclamación apostólica de la salvación a través de Jesucristo) inicial de los Apóstoles, y hacerla hoy una proclamación nuestra, debemos comenzar por desarrollar una relación personal con Dios en Cristo. ¿Es ésta relación personal un nuevo llamado o desconocido en la Iglesia Católica? No, desde el tiempo de nuestros Apóstoles, cada uno era invitado a ésta relación, Creyendo en Jesús y dando la vida por él, es la esencia de la conversión. Aquí hay algunos ejemplos que recientemente la Iglesia enseña, enfatizando la importancia de la relación personal con Jesús.

La conversión debe tomarse como única y suficiente para hacer que el hombre se dé cuenta de que ha sido alejado del pecado y llevado al misterio de amor de Dios, quien lo llamó a entablar **una relación con él en Cristo** (Vatican Council II, Ad, gentes,13).

...La proclamación inicial tiene un rol irremplazable y central, desde que introduce al hombre “dentro del misterio de amor de Dios”, quien lo ha invitado a entablar **una relación personal consigo mismo y con Cristo** y abrir la puerta de la conversión (Juan Pablo II, Redemptoris Missio, 44

(Nosotros no solamente) tenemos raciocinio y libertad, que constituyen características de la naturaleza humana, también desde el comienzo, la capacidad de tener **una relación personal con Dios**, como “tú” y “yo”...(Juan Pablo II, Dominum et Vicificantem, 34).

El verdadero significado de las Escrituras... En efecto, éste significado es inseparable de su objetivo, el cual es colocar a los creyentes dentro de **una relación personal con Dios** (Juan Pablo II, Discurso a la Comisión Pontificia Bíblica, 1993).

La Caridad es el corazón de la doctrina social de la Iglesia... Dá la substancia a **la relación personal con Dios** y con el prójimo (Benedicto XVI, Caritas in veritate, 2).


La oración y lectura llena de fé de la Biblia, con el tiempo profundizarán (en cada uno) **la relación personal con Jesús...** Mientras más crezcamos en nuestra relación personal con nuestro Señor Jesús, nos daremos cuenta que nos está llamando a la santidad (Benedicto XVI, Verbum Domini).

“La relación personal con Dios”, y entregarnos a su voluntad, pueden evitar que el hombre sea degradado o minimizado y caiga fácilmente presa del fanatismo y terrorismo (Benedicto XVI, Deus Caritas est, 37).

Invito a todos los Cristianos, de todas partes, en éste momento, a renovar su encuentro con Cristo Jesús, o al menos abrirse a él y encontrarlo, te lo pido lo hagas sin fallar cada día (Papa Francisco, Evangelii Gaudium, 3).

Todo el tiempo, los Papas siempre han insistido en ésto que es lo más importante — la necesidad de tener una real y viviente experiencia en nuestra relación con Jesús. Nosotros como comunidad debemos esforzarnos al máximo para hacer de ésto nuestra prioridad. Démonos el tiempo de oración, asistamos a la liturgia los domingos, sin fallar, enseñen a sus hijos (as) a leer la Biblia o a rezar el rosario, tengan una conversación profunda con alguien acerca de la fé en Jesús, comienza a ser un catequista, asiste a las clases de Biblia... Hay muchas más actividades que podemos hacer para alimentar nuestra relación personal con Jesús.

San Judas Tadeo Patrono de los casos imposibles y desesperados

El pasado 28 de Octubre se celebró la fiesta a éste Santo, la gran mayoría de los fieles católicos en todo el mundo invoca a San Judas Tadeo cuando se presentan situaciones difíciles y desesperadas, debido a que, en su carta, él hace énfasis en que los fieles deben perseverar en los momentos más duros que se nos presentan en la vida.

San Judas Tadeo fue pariente cercano de Jesús y uno de sus doce Apóstoles. Su hermano fue otro de los Apóstoles: Santiago el Menor. San Judas Tadeo viene de la descendencia de David y es primo de Jesucristo. El pueblo Judío, orgullosos de su linaje, mantuvieron registros exactos de sus antepasados, y vemos que el padre de San Judas Tadeo, Cleofás, era el hermano de San José. La madre de San Judas, María de Cleofás, era prima de la Santísima Virgen María: Sus madres eran hermanas.

En el Evangelio, a María de Cleofás se le identifica como la “hermana” quien tuvo el valor de permanecer a los pies de la Cruz de Cristo, junto con la Virgen María y San Juan.
