

# Our Mission Statement

As committed Christians of the Roman Catholic Church in Richmond, Indiana, we are a community, centered in Christ, rooted in the Eucharistic communion, journeying together in our call to be holy, constantly discerning the charisms of the Spirit, making one another disciples of Christ and seeking God's kingdom in service, stewardship and charity.

#### The Music of Advent

Advent is the beginning of the church year and prepares us for the season of Christmas. This year we begin the season on December 1<sup>st</sup>. Each liturgical season has a color along with specific music associated with it. For the season of Advent, we use the color of purple except on the third Sunday the color is replaced with rose. During Advent, we use a Mass setting set to the familiar tune of O Come ,O Come ,Emmanuel in a chant style format. Since Advent is a time of preparation, the music is a bit simpler while we are waiting for the joyful music of Christmas. The Gloria is not sung and we never sing Christmas songs at Mass until the actual season of Christmas begins on December 25<sup>th</sup>.

Advent is a season of waiting and preparation in which we hear of John the Baptist in the Scriptures. Therefore, we sing hymns of similar nature such as "Waiting in Silence" or "On Jordan's Banks". One of the newer songs from our Breaking Bread Hymnals is "Blessed and Holy" by Bernadette Farrell featuring the O Antiphons of Advent. The O Antiphons are poetry created by the Church to fill the liturgy with splendor. Each combines a laudatory invocation of the expected Messiah with a petition for his coming as Savior. These are also found during the prayers of each day in the Liturgy of the Hours. Another very popular song which heralds the O Antiphons in the verses is O Come, O Come Emmanuel. We reserve the actual hymn of O Come O Come Emmanuel to the forth Sunday of Advent since it calls us to Rejoice in the refrain of the song.

# A note from Fr. Sengole

We are entering into the holy time of Advent! While during Advent, we get ourselves busy with gift wrapping and writing Christmas cards, let us not forget that it is a time meant for preparation for the worthy celebration of our Lord's birth. Let us not forget that we are going to celebrate a historical event by which our the entire history of humanity got transformed. Christmas is celebration of a person. It is all about the celebration of our new life that Christ offered.

As we unwrap the Christmas gifts, let us also unwrap the gift of grace that Christ offered. This unwrapping of the eternal gift of grace is what we call conversion. Advent is a great time to unwrap the gift that God offered to us. That is gift is Jesus Christ!

May this Advent renew in us a greater commitment to live our Christian life. May we do all spiritual preparation that are necessary for the celebration of Christmas. True spiritual preparation lies in saying "no" to our selfish inclinations and saying a generous "YES" to the inclinations of the Spirit!

# Spanish/Español

### Mensaje por el Padre Sengole Gnanaraj

El 25 de Marzo del 2019, el Papa Francisco emitió una carta titulada Christ vivit (Cristo vive); es una exhortación apostólica post-sinodal a los jóvenesn y a todo el pueblo de Dios. Es una carta notable a través de la cual el Santo Padre se dirige a los jóvenes y los invita a comenzar a iniciar una relación con Jesús. A través de ésta carta, el Santo Padre cita a los diferentes jóvenes que respondieron a Dios en muchos eventos históricos diferentes, tanto bíblicos como en la historia de la Iglesia. Comenzando con el joven José y la joven Ruth en el Antiguo Testamento, y los jóvenes reales que se encontraron con Jesús y los personajes jóvenes que creó en sus parábolas en el Nuevo Testamento, el Papa resume en su carta el lugar que tienen los jóvenes en la Biblia. Él habla acerca de Nuestro Señor como un hombre joven que revolucionó al mundo siendo testigo del amor de Dios, seguido por María y todos los Santos jóvenes que brillan como estrellas en la Iglesia. Después el Papa pregunta ¿Qué tan relevante y amigable es la Iglesia con la gente joven? De diferentes formas, la Iglesia puede ser relevante y amigable para fomentar una verdadera espiritualidad para los jóvenes. Hablando del ambiente digital, él dice: "Es cierto que el mundo digital puede exponerte al riesgo de ser absorbido, aislado y vacío de placer. Pero no olvides que ahí hay gente joven, que muestra creatividad e ingenio. Ese fue el caso del Venerable Carlo Acutis" (CV 104).

¿Qué tipo de ministerio juvenil debería preveer una parroquia para los jóvenes? El Papa dá la línea de que cada parroquia debería, primero que nada, ofrecer oportunidades para la adoración auténtica de Dios en Cristo. En sus propias palabras: "Deseo simplemente enfatizar que un ministerio juvenil involucre dos caminos principales de acción: Uno es el alcance, esto es, la forma en que atraemos a nuevos jóvenes a una experiencia del Señor. El otro es el crecimiento, esto es, la forma en que ayudamos a aquéllos que ya han

tenido esa experiencia, a madurar" (CV 209). Las tres verdades que nuestra gente joven debe saberb acerca de nuestra fé, de acuerdo a ésta carta: 1) "Dios te ama" 2) Cristo por amor, se sacrificó para salvarte y 3) Cristo no es un modelo del pasado distante, ¡ Cristo vive!

¡ Sé que nuestro ministerio juvenil parroquial necesitaba ser detenido, a falta de un mejor término! Después de tres meses aquí en la Parroquia, siento firmemente que debemos revivir nuestro ministerio juvenil. Un ministro de jóvenes para nuestra parroquia, es una necesidad urgente! Con tu generosa ayuda y compromiso, esto es posible.

Lo repito, todo lo que hacemos es para contribuir a la misión de nuestra parroquia. ¿ Qué mejor trabajo podemos hacer por nuestra juventud que traerlos para que sean tocados por la misericordia y amor de Dios en Cristo?
