We welcome our brothers and sisters into our community

As you know we welcomed 14 new members this past Sunday! I was honored to initiate them into our Church, the body of Christ! Here is a brief synopsis of what I preached on that day!

Through the holy sacraments of baptism, confirmation and the Eucharist you are immersed into the very life of God. The very reason for God's incarnation is coming true in your life. God's eternal plan of salvation has reached you today. You have found God's mercy. You have been claimed to be God's beloved daughters and sons. You are

being configured to be Christs! Something unbelievable and something which our human hands could never achieve is happening right now! You are going to be touched by God's grace. You are going to be trusted with God's mission in the Church. You are going to be co-heirs to the heavenly riches which have been set wide open to you!

As Catholics, we believe in the communion of saints – an age old and a rich mystery of Christian life. You are part of the Church which is holy and heavenly, holy because God established this Church, heavenly because our head, Jesus, is in heaven! You are in communion with holy things and the holy persons. You are made saints today! This is made possible by the Spirit. This is the true meaning of the Greek word *Koinonia*. But this communion is both for the mission and misery of the Church (*Phil 1: 7, Synkoinonia*).

You are sealed in the Holy Spirit! On this day, when the whole Church is celebrating the holy feast of Pentecost – the outpouring of the Spirit in the life of the Church – you are receiving the Holy Spirit. The Spirit is the third Person in the Trinity. The Spirit is the love between God the Father and the Son, Jesus Christ. This pure love, pure knowledge and pure unity, the very Spirit of God is going to be poured into your life. Again, this is being made possible in and through Jesus Christ who died and rose from the dead. In Jesus, our humanity was blessed beyond understanding. In Jesus, our nature has touched the holy grounds of heaven. In Jesus, God has accustomed us to live in our nature. All this is made possible by the Spirit. You will rightfully and with holy fear call God, Our Father! You will do this through the help of the Holy Spirit which is poured into our hearts, crying 'Abba Father (Gal 4: 6). You will recognize Jesus as your savior and call him as Lord, again through the prompting of the Spirit, because "no one can say 'Jesus is Lord' except by the Holy Spirit" (1 Cor 12: 3). You will be able to pray in such a way that you will know the will of God the Father for your lives, again through the help of the Holy Spirit – "we do not know how to pray as we ought, but the Spirit himself intercedes for us with sighs too deep for words. And he



who searches the hearts of men knows what is the mind of the Spirit because the Spirit intercedes for the saints according to the will of God" (Rom 8: 26ff). St. Gregory of Nazianzus says, "No one comprehends the thoughts of God except the Spirit of God." The Spirit will enable you to hear the Father's Word.

You are baptized in the Spirit! Now, sweet and pleasing as it may sound – in simple language you are actually given a blank check from God!! Yes, that is correct – what would a blank check from God look like? It is up to you to unlock the powers of God's grace. You

are called to cooperate with Grace. Just like a medicine that works in the body in as much it cooperates with it, you will receive God's bountiful mercy and his enduring love. Do not make it dormant! "Do not grieve the Holy Spirit in which you were sealed for the day of redemption" (Eph 4: 31). You are not called to an individualistic life, totally centered on you in such a way that you and God are nothing to do with those you love!! This is the community in which you are planted and called to bear fruit.

You are called to immerse yourself into the mission of this parish community St. Elizabeth Ann Seton. This community will strengthen you. This community will accompany you all the way from birth to death. We need you for our growth! The Spirit, according to his will bestows individuals with the gifts of charisms, purely and only for the reason of building up the body of Christ (Eph 4: 12). We need you for this community. You are now the rightful beneficiaries of all the spiritual wealth of this community. Also remember, the only reason you receive the Holy Spirit is to make you like Christ. That is the correct definition of spirituality – the Spirit reproduces in us the same life of Christ. Seek Christ, love Christ and be Christ! Never forget that you are part of this community! Come often and worship with us. Join us in our mission of making everyone disciples of Christ! Share your blessings!!

El pasado domingo 31 de Marzo del 2020 celebramos Pentecostés, que significa 50 días después de la Pascua (Domingo de Resurrección). El inicio de la Iglesia Católica. Hechos de los Apóstoles 2:1-41. El descenso del Espíritu Santo en María Madre de Dios, los Apóstoles y demás mujeres que estaban en oración. "Todos quedaron muy desconcertados porque cada uno los oía hablar en su propia lengua." (Hechos 2:6). Pentecostés es un estallido del poder de Dios que toca el fondo del corazón de cada persona que está presente. Eso es lo que experimentaron los discípulos aquel día y es lo que la Iglesia experimenta ahora en cada persona que se deja guiar por el Espíritu. Jesús ha sido el portador del Espíritu Santo. La comunidad cristiana nace en este momento y tiene como modelo a Jesús. El Espíritu Santo tiene el papel central de nuestra vida cristiana. Sin él, nada podemos hacer; la vida de fé sería sólo vana ilusión. El Espíritu todo lo unifica; con él se terminan los desacuerdos, todo se entiende, se habla el mismo idioma. Hoy celebramos la victoria Pascual de Jesucristo y esto llena de gozo la liturgia. ¡Ven Espíritu Santo y danos tus siete dones! Para llenarnos del fuego de tu amor en la familia, comunidad y en la sociedad en general. Para sanar nuestros corazones heridos de tanta violencia e injusticia. Para fortalecernos en nuestras debilidades. Para que seamos misioneros entregados al fuego de tu amor. La Pascua termina con esta celebración, pero el fuego en el corazón nunca debe de irse. "La historia de los discípulos, que parecía haber llegado a su final, es en definitiva renovada por la juventud del Espíritu: Aquéllos jóvenes que, poseídos por la incertidumbre pensaban que habían llegado al final, fueron transformados por una alegría que los hizo renacer. El Espíritu Santo hizo esto." (Papa Francisco Homilía de Pentecostés).

10 reflexiones que ha realizado el Papa sobre la Tercera Persona la Santísima Trinidad.

1 Sin Él no somos cristianos

En su homilía del 13 de mayo en la capilla de Santa Marta, explicó que sin el Espíritu no somos cristianos, no existe la Iglesia ni su misión. Sin El vivimos una doble vida: Cristianos en palabras, "mundanos" en hechos.

2 Nos hace vivir como resucitados

"Su historia nos dice que incluso ver al Resucitado no es suficiente si no lo acogemos en nuestros corazones. No sirve saber que el Resucitado está vivo si no se vive como un resucitado. Y es el Espíritu que hace que Jesús viva y reviva en nosotros, que nos resucita", dijo la Homilía de Pentecostés de 2019

3 Nos reafirma como hijos de Dios.

"El apóstol Pablo, escribiendo a los cristianos de Roma, dice: «Los que se dejan llevar por el Espíritu de Dios, esos son hijos de Dios. Habéis recibido, no un espíritu de esclavitud, para recaer en el temor, sino un espíritu de hijos adoptivos, que nos hace gritar: ¡Abba, Padre!» (Rm 8,14-15). He aquí la relación reestablecida: la paternidad de Dios se reaviva en nosotros a través de la obra redentora de Cristo y del don del Espíritu Santo", dijo el Santo Padre en Pentecostés 2016.

4 El alma de la Iglesia

Él da la vida, suscita los diferentes carismas que enriquecen al Pueblo de Dios y, sobre todo, crea la unidad entre los creyentes: de muchos, hace un solo cuerpo, el cuerpo de Cristo. Toda la vida y la misión de la Iglesia dependen del Espíritu Santo; él realiza todas las cosas.

5 Unidad en la diversidad

La división entre los cristianos es uno de los grandes escándalos que nos aleja de la fé. El diablo divide, mientras que "el Espíritu hace que los discípulos sean un pueblo nuevo", porque "crea un corazón nuevo". "A cada uno da un don y a todos



reúne en unidad. En otras palabras, el mismo Espíritu crea la diversidad y la unidad",

6 El Espíritu del perdón

Jesús Resucitado, en la primera vez que se aparece a los suyos, dice: «Recibid el Espíritu Santo; a quienes les perdonéis los pecados, les quedan perdonados» (*Jn* 20, 22-23). Jesús no los condena, a pesar de que lo habían abandonado y negado durante la Pasión, sino que les da el Espíritu de perdón. El Espíritu es el primer don del Resucitado y se da en primer lugar para perdonar los pecados. Este es el comienzo de la Iglesia, este es el aglutinante que nos mantiene unidos, el cemento que une los ladrillos de la casa: *el perdón*. Porque el perdón es el don por excelencia, es el amor más grande, el que mantiene unidos a pesar de todo, que evita el colapso, que refuerza y fortalece. El perdón libera el corazón y le permite recomenzar: El perdón da esperanza, sin perdón no se construye la Iglesia.

7. Dios nos habla todavía hoy

El Espíritu de verdad nunca deja de hablar, nos hace entrar cada vez más plenamente en el significado de las palabras de Jesús. Es la novedad del Evangelio, de una Palabra siempre viva, porque el cristianismo, como dice el Catecismo de la Iglesia Católica, no es una "religión del Libro", "una palabra escrita y muda", sino de la Palabra de Dios, es decir, el Verbo encarnado y vivo.

8. Las resistencias al Espíritu Santo

La Iglesia se muestra fiel al Espíritu Santo cuando deja de lado la tentación de mirarse a sí misma. Y nosotros, los cristianos, nos convertimos en auténticos discípulos misioneros, capaces de interpelar las conciencias, si abandonamos un estilo defensivo para dejarnos conducir por el Espíritu.

9. La alegría del Espíritu

Sólo pueden ser misioneros los que se sienten bien buscando el bien de los demás, los que desean la felicidad de los demás. Si puedo ayudar a una persona a vivir mejor, esto ya basta para justificar el don de mi vida. La alegría, la paz, el amor, son frutos del Espíritu.

10. Los carismas de la Iglesia

El Espíritu Santo suscita los diferentes carismas en la Iglesia; en apariencia, esto parece crear desorden, pero en realidad, bajo su guía, es una inmensa riqueza, porque el Espíritu Santo es el Espíritu de unidad, que no significa uniformidad. Sólo el Espíritu Santo puede suscitar la diversidad, la multiplicidad y, al mismo tiempo, producir la unidad. (Arguidiócesis de México. Desde la fé).

More than anything, Chuck will miss interacting with curious students and with his colleagues.


His plans for retirement are simply to stay healthy.


