Dear Parishioners,

The idea of conversion has always remained a fascinating thing in my life. The Archdiocesan weekly newspaper, *Criterion*, has featured articles on people incarcerated and particularly those on capital punishment. Archbishop Thompson said that conversion is a lifelong process, and it is a journey one takes for the entire life. So, we understand conversion as something that is an everyday thing. Not a single day passes without our responding to the invitation our Lord offers to move closer to him. Conversion is a movement. It is moving away from sin and moving closer to Jesus. We cannot go to God and be attached to sin at the same time. When Jesus said, "Come to me, all you who labor and are burdened, I will give you rest," we should first of all see the burden as the weight of sin.

Conversion means that we live, love and understand, perceive and deal with people in a new way. There are four levels or stages of conversion: moral, affective, intellectual and spiritual conversion. They do not happen one after another; they can happen all at once like we see in St. Paul and St. Augustine - a radical and total change of life in response to the Gospel - or gradually, as we mature in our discipleship.

Now, moral conversion is not a matter of choosing new values (content), but it is about choosing value as the criterion of one's choices. For example, the church teaches that artificial contraception is sinful because the value that is at stake is the transmission of life. Are we able to see the value that may be at stake in our actions, because we want to grow in our discipleship?

Effective conversion is not primarily about loving someone new (content) but allowing love to become the central reality, the dynamic principle of Christian life. For example, it is not love if we stop loving a person because that person behaved badly or that person did not merit our love for whatever reason we may use to justify. Do we love people for love's sake?

Intellectual conversion (cognitive) is not about knowing something new (content) even if it is about our faith! It is about understanding one's knowing and understanding oneself in a new way. The process of knowing something largely depends on knowing myself first. I want to know and understand as a son/daughter of God. Are we conscious of the fact each day that we are called to be children of God - brothers and sisters of Christ?

Religious conversion is not a matter of new forms of prayer and worship (content), but it is all about allowing God to move from the edges to the center of one's life, transforming one's very way of being. Do I pray because I love God? Or do I pray because I will feel guilty of not praying?

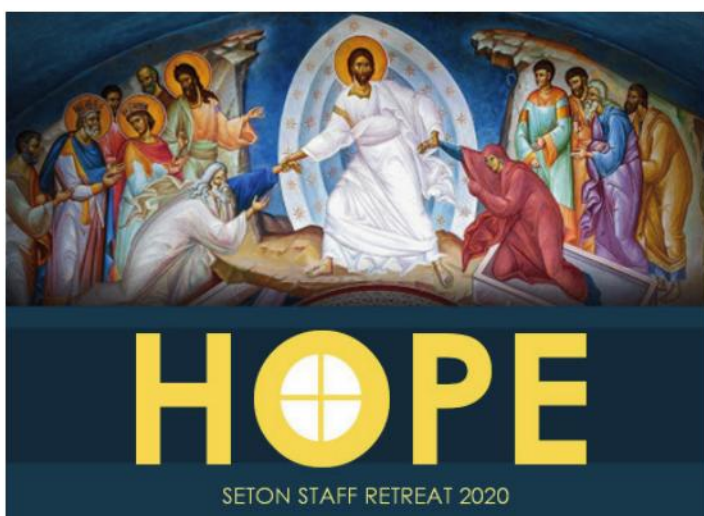

El Señor nos llama a la fidelidad en lo pequeño, humilde y secreto. Quiero recordar a un esposo, padre, hombre de Dios colombiano, que a pesar de todo lo que ocurrió en su vida, hoy es un evangelizador al igual que toda su familia.

Él es un comerciante de pescado y carne de puerco, más no le interesa tanto vender como el plat-

icar con la gente que está pasando por momentos difíciles, conocer sus necesidades y ayudarles. En lo pequeño está construyendo el reino de Dios. La Madre Teresa decía: “Lo que hacemos es tan sólo una gota en el mar, pero el mar no sería el mismo si le faltara esa gota”. En el **reino de Dios se juega en esa inmensa catarata de gestos pequeños** con que a diario el Señor nos invita a construir su reino, una sonrisa a tiempo, una palabra de aliento, un abrazo de paz, una escucha atenta a quien necesita ser escuchado, le podemos hablar a una persona de Dios, recuerda que en lo pequeño se va construyendo el reino de Dios. 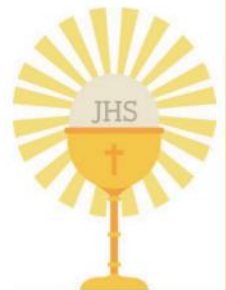
