

### Pandemic Reflection

I was reflecting on these days of pandemic - can't believe we are in a shut-down mode for about 7 months. It is really heartening to see many of you coming back to Church. I am truly edified by your faith and commitment to our parish. That being said, I do want to see more young people and young families coming back to Church! Of course, we are not back to normal Church, that means we still need to follow protocols - safe distance, face mask, self-monitoring, hand sanitizing etc.

What makes me happy is the many ways we got to be alive even during this difficult time. We have been praying the rosary since March, on the parish Facebook page at 7:30pm. Kyle King, our parish catechetical leader is leading Bible study series on Wednesdays at 7:30pm - again since this past March! Our parish has started Young Adults formation and we have formed 5 groups of 5 young adults. We meet online to pray, grow and enrich each other. Youth meetings are regularly taking place - with all protocols in place!

In the next week, we will be initiating what is called, "Tele Ministry of Presence and Prayer." Seminarians at Meinrad School of Theology are being assigned parishes for this ministry. All that they would do is to periodically call parishioners who are sick or elderly, pray with them and be with them. Our own seminarian Jack Wright has been assigned to our parish. I am gathering a list of parishioners to ask him to call for this ministry. I see this as a great ministry that will certainly help seminarians grow in holiness and learn the many faces of pastoral ministries of prayer and presence. This ministry will be monitored and supervised by me at all levels until they are done. If you want your family members to be contacted, please let me know via email:




**Attention Parents:** 5 Reasons to Keep your Teenagers Involved in Youth Ministry.

Parents are the primary source of spiritual development in their children, however, other adults of the church community play a vital role in growing and pruning our children into strong Catholic/Christian adults.

- Teenagers Need Role Models and Mentors (Titus 2:1-8) "Likewise, teach the older women to be reverent in the way they live, not to be slanderers or addicted to much wine, but to teach what is good. Then they can urge the younger women to love their husbands and children, to be self-controlled and pure, to be busy at home, to be kind, and to be subject to their husbands, so that no one will malign the word of God. Similarly, encourage the young men to be self-controlled. In everything set them an example by doing what is good. In your teaching show integrity, seriousness and soundness of speech that cannot be condemned, so that those who oppose you may be ashamed because they have nothing bad to say about us."
- Teenagers Need Community (Hebrews 10:24,25) "And let us consider how we may spur one another on toward love and good deeds, not giving up meeting together, as some are in the habit of doing, but encouraging one another—and all the more as you see the Day approaching."



### Ave María Llena Eres de Gracia

El 8 de Septiembre celebramos el nacimiento de la Santísima Virgen María. Esto es exactamente nueve meses después de la fiesta de la Inmaculada Concepción el 8 de Diciembre. El nacimiento de nuestra Señora no se encuentra en el Evangelio ni en otras partes del Nuevo Testamento. Los Evangelios tratan enteramente sobre la obra salvífica de nuestro Señor. En su mayor parte, la fuente más antigua se relata en el Protevangelium de Santiago (5:2), un escrito apócrifo de finales del siglo II. Toda la tradición posterior se basa en esta cuenta. Debemos ver esta fiesta en el panorama más amplio de nuestra salvación. El lugar de María en nuestra tradición de fé está inseparablemente conectado con el Señor. No hay lugar para María si no está estrechamente relacionada con el Señor. El lugar de María en la vida de la Iglesia es enteramente cristológico. Los siguientes textos de las Escrituras nos dan una idea del misterio de nuestra salvación y, por tanto, de la historia de la tradición mariana en la Iglesia.


Miqueas 5:1-4a. El profeta Miqueas anuncia la venida del Señor de Israel, que saldrá de Belén de Judá. La Madre del Mesías, presentada como a punto de dar a luz, dará vida al príncipe y pastor de la casa de David que traerá justicia y paz. Ella trabajará con el Mesías para traer un nuevo pueblo. Aunque las palabras del Antiguo Testamento con respecto a María denotan sólo remotamente su identidad, es decir, "mujer joven" o más tarde, "virgen", es Cristo quien arroja luz sobre el lugar y la identidad de la Madre del Señor.

Romanos 8:28-30. Este pasaje no habla directamente de María, sino del creyente justificado por la gracia de Cristo y dotado de la morada del Espíritu. Él o ella ha sido elegido y llamado desde toda la eternidad para compartir la vida y la gloria de Cristo. Esto es cierto de manera privilegiada para María, que es Esposa, Templo del Espíritu Santo, Madre del Hijo de Dios, e íntimamente unida a Él en un plan divino de predestino y gracia.

Mateo 1:1-16, 18-23. El significado de este relato genealógico es teológicamente profundo, ya que coloca a Jesucristo, dentro del árbol dinástico de su pueblo. Él es un descendiente, y de hecho "el descendiente" de Abraham (cf. Gálatas 3:16) y los Patriarcas de acuerdo con las promesas, y es el semi-heredero de los Profetas. El anillo que unió a Cristo con su pueblo es María, Hija de Sión y Madre del Señor.

Nuestra fé revela que María debe estar en el plan eterno de Dios como el plan de salvación es eterno. Es por eso que María debe considerarse inmaculadamente concebida. Porque ¿Cómo concebir a Dios en una mujer que no está libre del pecado original? El nacimiento de nuestra Madre solo aumenta nuestra gratitud por el generoso amor de Dios por nosotros. El plan de salvación de Dios revela todas las maravillas tanto visibles como ocultas. ¡Tal es la belleza de nuestra fé!
