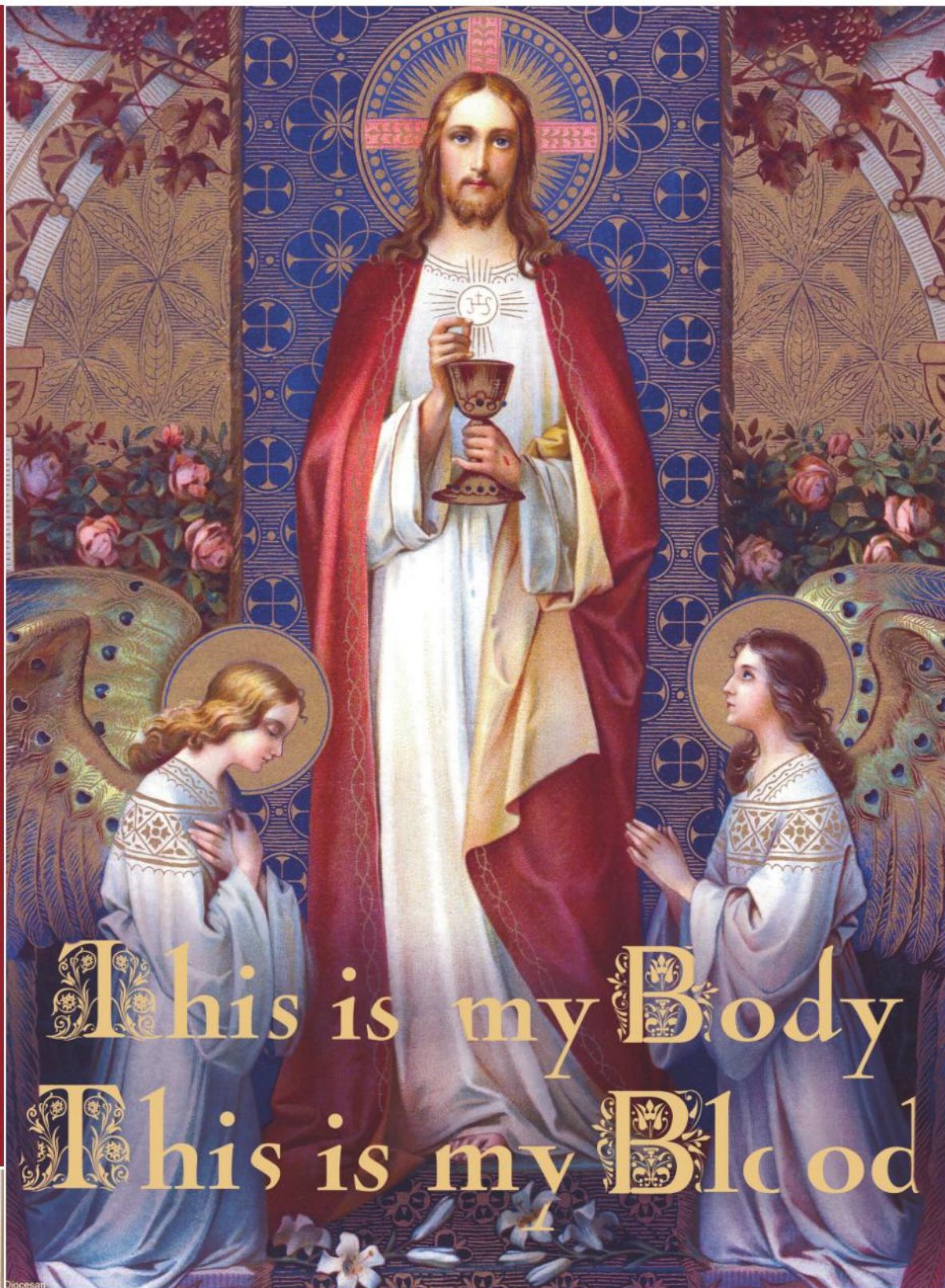

Feast of *Corpus Christi*

This weekend we celebrate the feast of Corpus Christi. In line with the major feasts that we celebrated in the past weeks, the feast of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Jesus Christ has a natural progression in meaning. This feast originated in 1246. The most prominent aspect of this feast is the Eucharistic procession outside the church. Most separated brothers and sisters do not celebrate this feast as they reject the doctrine of transmutation (the changing of the ordinary host and wine into the real body and blood of Christ). When an opportune time comes, we will reintroduce the Eucharistic procession.

This feast also reminds us of the historical origins of some famous hymns that we sing. Pope Urban asked Thomas Aquinas, one of the greatest theologians of the Church, to compose the text for the Liturgical Office for this new feast. Among the many writings, his famous hymn *Pange Lingua* (*Tantum ergo...*) which we sing at every Eucharistic adoration and benediction.

Adoration of the Blessed Sacrament is a rich tradition of the Catholic Church. We have two opportunities in a week for adoration (Tuesday and Friday at 6pm at Holy Family). What do we do in the silence of this hour with the Lord? Well, we can spend the entire time in silence or pray for someone who needs your prayers, read the Bible, do an examination of conscience – more importantly converse with the Lord as you would with a close friend. Surrendering ourselves in humility for His mercy is the greatest of the habits for a disciple.

God comes into communion with us as we receive the Lord. That is why it is called “holy communion.” It is a must that we are free of mortal sins as we enter into this communion. Anything that has harmed our communion with the Church must be healed to be restored before we bring ourselves to communion with the Lord. When we partake of this one cup and one bread, we cannot partake in the evil ways of the world (1 Cor 11). The Holy Mass is a source and summit of all Christian life. It is from it we avail the riches of heavenly grace. What Jesus offered by shedding His precious blood, we continue to offer for the same purpose – salvation of souls. When one drop of His blood would have brought salvation for the world, he shed all of it – such is God’s mercy.
