Is your Faith Asleep or Awake?

Dear friends,

The public ministry of Jesus is usually comprised of two streams. One, Jesus preached. Second, He performed miracles. The miracles of Jesus are visible signs of the content of Jesus' preaching which is primarily the announcement of God's kingdom and his invitation to enter into the kingdom. God's kingdom and subsequently, all values and virtues corresponding to a life in the kingdom are not mere ideals. They are moral absolutes. Why we do what we do is qualified by the values of God's kingdom.

The first requirement is faith. Without faith nothing is meaningful. Christian life is a life lived in Christ and with Christ. Christ is with us. The words that Jesus uses here (v. 40; cf. 5:36) teach us a perennial truth: faith conquers fear; if we have faith in Jesus, nothing can disturb our peace: "Christian, Christ is asleep in your boat. Wake him up, and he will calm the storm and your fears. [...] You are afraid because you are asleep; you are tossed about on the stormy desires raised by the breath of those


who tempt you to do evil because your faith is asleep. 'Your faith is asleep' means you have forgotten your faith. To wake Christ means to awaken your faith, to recall what you believe. Remember your faith; wake Christ within you. Your faith will immediately still the frightening winds and waves of those who tempt you to do evil" (St Augustine, *Sermons*, 361, 7).

May we pray for the increase of our faith, faith that reminds us of Christ's presence!

Sisters of St. Theresa of Bukoba


