


Feast of Christ the King

Dear parishioners,

I will be making my personal annual retreat in New Jersey this upcoming week. Please keep me in your prayers!

As always, we end the liturgical year with the feast of the Solemnity of Christ the King of the Universe. Pope Pius XI instituted this feast in 1925 with his encyclical Quas Primas ("In the first") to respond to growing nationalism and secularism. He recognized that these related societal ills would breed increasing hostility against the Church. His encyclical reminds the faithful that while governments and philosophies come and go, Christ reigns as king forever.

We celebrate not only Christ as being the King, but we also celebrate His Kingdom as it unfolds among us. Remember, when Jesus preaches for the first time, he said, "The time fulfilled, and the kingdom of God is at hand; repent and believe in the gospel" (Mk 1:14-15). He repeatedly said that the kingdom is among you. He also used many imageries like the yeast and the flour. Asking, Jesus was in himself the kingdom of God. It is by joining ourselves unto him we become the kingdom that Jesus wanted to flourish on this earth. Pope Francis said, "The kingdom, already present and growing in our midst, engages us at every level of our being and reminds us of the principle of discernment which Pope Paul VI applied to true development: it must be directed to 'all men and the whole man' (Evangelii gaudium, 181).

Now, this feast invites us to recognize Jesus in our lives as king and as when the subjects surrender themselves to a king, we must surrender our lives to Jesus. The values of this kingdom are not of this world, literally, not of this world! In order that we inculcate the values of Jesus' kingdom, we must lis-

ten attentively to what he tells us and follow him in committing ourselves to do them. What values of the kingdom are we not aware of yet? And what values of His kingdom do we struggle to live by? The beatitude (Mt 5:1-12) give us a brief introduction to these values. You may want to take a look at!


May Christ reign in our personal and interior lives. May we become like Jesus in everything we seek and do.
