Preparing for Advent

Dear Parish Family,

We are in the holy time of Advent now. As always, this special time signifies both to the penitential character and at the same time to the joy of Christmas. The word "Advent" simply means "coming." For us this means the great coming of Jesus both in the past history as well as, in a metaphorical way to the second coming. "In Advent, Christians re-live a dual impulse of the spirit: on the one hand, they raise their eyes towards the final destination of their pilgrimage through history, which is the glorious return of the Lord Jesus; on the other, remembering with emotion his birth in Bethlehem, they kneel before the Crib" (Pope Benedict XVI).

Preparing ourselves for the Christmas which is the first coming of Jesus, we actually get accustomed to the true preparation for the second coming of Jesus. Accordingly, the readings of Advent season will be set in a tone of patient waiting and warning. That is why, advent is par excellence the season of hope in which believers in Christ are invited to remain in watchful and active waiting, nourished by prayer and by the effective commitment to love. Before Jesus began his public ministry, John the Baptist took care of the preparation for his coming. He in fact preached to the people a baptism of repentance for the forgiveness of sins. Even for us today, his message must ring out in our hearts evoking the proper response to Christ's coming in Christmas.

At Christmas, we will encounter Jesus in a joy-filled atmosphere. That joy must be true. We will tell the world that the Savior is born. The world needs God today more than any other time. The world needs God – not just any god but the God of Jesus Christ, the God who made Himself flesh and blood, who loved us to the point of dying for us, who rose and created within Himself room for man.

May we enter this holy season, acutely aware of our need for God's peace in this world!
