# Third Sunday of Advent - Gaudete Sunday

This weekend, we celebrate Gaudete Sunday - Rejoice Sunday. Gaudete in Latin means Rejoice.

St. Paul writes to the Thessalonian community

"Brothers and sisters: Rejoice always. Pray without ceasing. In all circumstances give thanks, for this is the will of God for you in Christ Jesus."

We are midway to Christmas during this Advent. The Church encourages us to be joyful and exuberant, as we near the birth of our Lord Jesus. Oftentimes, we think that we need a reason for being joyful. Joy is not the opposite of being gloomy, sad and distraught. Joy is the original emotion that God gave to each of us. When we are born, everyone around us is so naturally filled with joy; we do that too - a little infant can bring into our life immeasurable joy. We are called to remind ourselves that our joy is complete and nothing of this world can take away. Jesus' birth reminds the whole world the importance of joy in our life. Even amidst trials and suffering, we are called to get in touch with this original emotion. Our joy reminds us of the many beautiful things that surround us, and particularly God who is so full of compassion and all goodness.

Pope Benedict XVI said, "Now, someone could ask whether it is right to be so happy when the world is so full of suffering, when there exists so much darkness and evil? Is it right to be so high spir-

ited and joyful? The answer can only be 'yes!' Because saying 'no' to joy we do nothing of use to anyone, we only make the world darker. And whoever does not love himself cannot give anything to his neighbor, he cannot help him, he cannot be a messenger of peace.

From our faith we know and every day we see that the world is beautiful and God is good. And because of the fact that he became man and dwelled among us we know it definitively and concretely: yes, God is good and it is good to be a person. We live in this joy, and from this joy we try to bring joy to others, to reject evil and to be servants of peace and reconciliation."

If at all we need a reason to be joyful, there is no other reason other than the truth that God is with us! When in God's presence, there is no place for anything that is bad. If you are not able to see God's presence right now, look back in your life and see God's providential hand in each and every moment you needed help!


