

Dear parishioners,

Someone asked me after Mass this past Sunday as to who should be attending Evangelize 3:16 workshop. Good question! I replied, "anyone, practicing Catholic or non-practicing, those regularly attending Church and those who are lukewarm!" And then, I came up with the following questions which may help you decide if you should attend these sessions.

How different are Evangelization workshops from RCIA?

In typical RCIA classes, we will be learning much about the Catholic faith in general, and those sessions are tailored for people who are new converts. RCIA is a basic introduction to what Catholics believe and practice. Evangelization, on the other hand, is replicating what the Apostles 2000 years ago preached. The apostles encountered a pagan world and they were charged with a mission directly from our Lord to go out and to preach the Gospel to all nations. We are Apostolic, meaning we are called to be like the Apostles today.

What is the difference between Catechesis and Evangelization?

This is how the Catechism defines Evangelization: "The proclamation of Christ and his Gospel by word and the testimony of life, in fulfillment of Christ's command" (CCC 905). And, Catechesis is usually defined as, "Catechesis is an education in the faith of children, young people and adults which includes especially the teaching of Christian doctrine imparted, generally speaking, in an organic and systematic way, with a view to initiating the hearers into the fullness of Christian life" (CCC 5). The crucial question is how can we expect Catechesis to be successful if those who are catechized are not evangelized? Or, how can we expect our children to deepen their faith if they do not have a family that is deeply

committed to our Lord? If parents do not practice their faith, if they do not commit to going to Sunday Church each week, their children will easily be discouraged, to the point of relegating faith to something least bothered. If this kicks on early on in a child's life, there is not much to hope for! In short, in a community that is well evangelized, Catechesis will flourish.

I regularly attend Mass and am a devout Catholic, should I attend Evangelization workshop?

Of course! During these sessions, we are repeating the Kerygma (the heart of the Gospel), in doing so, we will answer questions regarding common misconceptions of sins, one's journey of conversion, life in the Spirit and how each baptized is called to evangelize etc.

What books are we reading during these sessions? The Holy Bible!

We named this Evangelization workshop as "Evangelize 3:16" partly because we will be studying important Scripture verses that are all verse 16. Here are the eight verses: Rom 1:16, Acts 3:16, Jn 3:16, Mk 16: 16, Rom 8:16, 1Cor 9:16, Acts 11:16 and Gal 5:16.

Why only 16 people in a session?

A typical student teacher ratio is 1:15. Moreover, we want to be intentional in evangelizing, and so instead of doing it just once or twice for a larger crowd, we would like to do it for smaller groups, and thus making it a year long project. Moreover, our scripture verses are 16!

One last remark is that these sessions are moved to **Sundays**! It will take place at the High School cafeteria after 10 am Mass. Please join us!
