

St. Valentine was a Roman priest martyred during Claudius' reign. The story tells that St. Valentine was imprisoned for marrying Christian couples and aiding Christians being persecuted by Claudius in Rome. Both acts were considered serious crimes. A relationship between the saint and emperor began to grow, until Valentine attempted to convince Claudius of Christianity. Claudius became raged and sentenced Valentine to death, commanding him to renounce his faith or be beaten with clubs and beheaded. St. Valentine refused to renounce his faith and Christianity and was executed outside the Flaminian Gate on February 14, 269.

### Beatitudes

This week's Gospel (Luke 6:17, 20–26) is very similar to Matthew 5:1-12. The eight (or nine) Beatitudes of Matthew are summed up by Luke in four, to which are attached four antitheses or "Woes". These passages are generally called the Beatitudes (the Be-Attitudes, if you would like to call it that way!) But in both cases, "the beatitude we are promised confronts us with decisive moral choices. The Beatitudes invite us to purify our hearts of bad instincts and to seek the love of God above all else. It teaches us that true happiness is not found in riches or well-being, in human fame or power, or in any human achievement—however beneficial it may be—such as science, technology, and art, or indeed in any creature, but in God alone, the source of every good and of all love" (CCC. 1723).

In Luke, as contrasted by Matthew, Jesus speaks in the second person, addressing the disciples and the crowd that gathered around Him. "Blessed are you who are poor, for yours is the Kingdom of God." In Matthew, it is, "Blessed are the poor in spirit, for theirs is the kingdom of heaven." The Greek word for "blessed" is Makarios. Luke helps us to understand the nature of discipleship.

Jesus addresses the disciples, looking at their faces. Those who are disciples of Jesus must embrace this invitation and live a life that bespeaks of discipleship to Jesus. All the saints of the Church took this invitation seriously and gave up their lives for the Gospel. In fact, Jesus himself becomes the model of the beatitudes. It is his self-description. The path that Jesus embraced exactly represents the true life of the blessedness. Jesus was truly poor, hungry, wept for Jerusalem and was hated by many people. Jesus, as his faith in God taught him, had such a wonderful attitude of fortitude amidst all forms of humiliation, even to the point of dying on the cross.

This weekend, pray on the beatitudes of Matthew and Luke. As you read them, try to imagine the life of Jesus in all the categories of blessedness. The blessings and the promises of Jesus in the beauties are our own pattern for spiritual life. If you have a doubt on any of the blessedness (ex. What does it mean to be merciful?) look at Jesus on the cross. The cross is the answer to the beatitudes. The beatitudes can also be an examination of conscience.


