

#### Dear parishioners,

"The one who sings prays twice". ... He that sings praise, not only sings, but also loves him of whom he sings. In praise, there is the speaking forth of one confessing; in singing, the affection of one loving" (St. Augustine). We are so blessed to have committed and talented musicians and cantors in our parish. This past Saturday, our music ministry team met and went over some of the essential Church teachings on music in the divine liturgy. I am really happy to see young musicians working hard on their talents despite their other academic responsibilities. I am grateful to their parents and their teachers for mentoring good budding musicians in our community. Much appreciations also to our senior musicians who help them!

In 2007, the US bishops issued important guidelines in the form a book entitled, "Sing to the Lord: Music in Divine Worship." This book has all that we want to know about music in divine worship. Through this book our Bishops encourage and affirm the use of traditional sacred music—old music, new music, and music of various styles and cultures. Catholic tradition has preserved some age old practices of divine worship especially in the field of music. Although, the Gregorian Chant is considered a distinctive of the Roman liturgy and is given the pride of place in liturgical services, other kinds of sacred music, especially polyphony are not excluded from liturgical celebrations. I enjoy listening to the folk group and the chants during Lent. All our cantors are truly blessed with God given talents. So are our musicians.

Although many think that all music is the same and there is not much to differentiate, in general, there is a classical distinction between the "sacred" music and "profane" music. By sacred what we mean is that which is excluded from ordinary reality, related in some way to the proximity or density of the divine presence. By profane we do not mean "unholy" but that which is not suited for a divine worship. We do have a good definition of sacred music from the a document called *Sacrasanctum Concilium* of the Second Vatican Council: "Sacred music will be the more holy the more closely it is joined to the liturgical rite, whether by adding delight to prayer, fostering oneness of spirit, or investing the rites with greater solemnity." We should see this definition in the light of what Thomas Aquinas said about sacredness. "A thing is sacred (sacrum) by virtue of its relation to divine worship (ad cultum dininum).

At the Holy Mass, music is set to parts that are strictly part of Mass (parts of Mass) and other hymns that can stand alone by its very nature. All music during the Holy Mass must be done with utmost seriousness, preparation and commitment because they help everyone to participate well and at the same time enhance the meaning of the mysteries of our faith. John Paul II said, "The effectiveness of [Christ's] action [in the Eucharist] is a fruit of the work of the Holy Spirit but also requires a human response." All hymns and music must be geared towards enhancing this response in a meaningful and fruitful way. Here lies the place of music in divine worship! Join me in congratulating and appreciating our music team!
