## Holy Week

With Palm Sunday we begin the Holy Week. "Holy Week is ordered to the commemoration of Christ's Passion, beginning with his Messianic entrance into Jerusalem" (Universal Norms, 31). On this day, the Church recalls the entrance of Christ the Lord into Jerusalem to accomplish his Paschal Mystery. Accordingly, the memorial of this entrance of the Lord takes place at all Masses, by means of a simple procession or the solemn entrance before the principal Mass.

As usual, I will be joining the Chrism Mass, celebrated by Archbishop Charles Thompson at the Cathedral in Indianapolis. On two occasions, the entire presbyterate (all priests) joins the Archbishop - once during the annual Chrism Mass and occasionally during priesthood ordination. During the Chrism Mass, priests renew their priestly promises and in doing so, they promise to obey the bishop, commit to a life of celibacy and poverty.

On Holy Thursday, the washing of the feet and the institution of the Holy Eucharist in the Passover meal of Jesus is commemorated. While the foot washing signifies Christ's servanthood (servant of humanity) the Eucharist signifies to his enduring presence in the Church which continues the sanctifying mission of Christ. The tabernacle will be left empty and open signifying to Christ's death and his tomb.

On Good Friday, we will kiss and adore the cross, followed by communion service. During Good Friday the Church will make the traditional solemn intercessions for the world and all those who are in need of God's mercy. Good Friday is the only day, the Church does not celebrate the Holy Mass, instead we immerse ourselves into the passion and death of Christ.

On Easter Vigil Saturday, we celebrate the resurrection of Jesus Christ; during which we will be renewing our baptismal promises. It is a rich ceremony packed with actions and meanings. We are so blessed to have 4 Catechumens for baptism, 5 Candidates for full communion with the Catholic Church by receiving Confirmation and Holy Communion and 1 candidate for Confirmation (a total 10 new members!). I want to thank Evelyn Miller and Deacon Jim Miller for coordinating the RCIA classes with all those who accompanied these brothers and sisters!

May we have the heart and mind of Christ, during this Holy Week, seeking to do the will of God for our own lives, just like our Lord did, even by dying on the cross, bleeding to death for the sake of his mercy for the entire humanity!

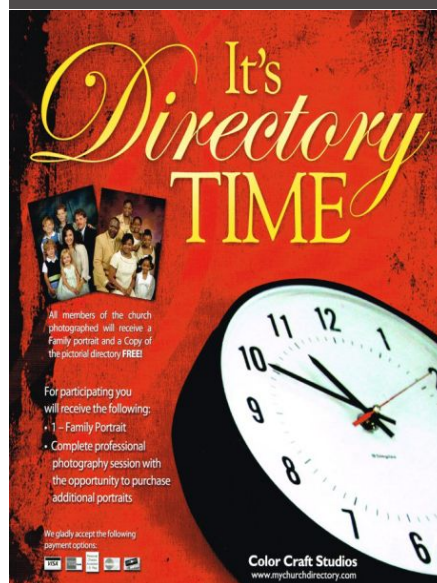

## NEW CHURCH PICTORIAL DIRECTORY



Our last directory was completed in 2017 and it is time to publish an updated directory. The former company, Life-touch, is no longer in the church directory business. We have contracted Colorcraft to provide our new directory.

Our last directory featured about one-half of our parishioners. We want everyone to be included this time. With more than 900 registered parishioners households, this will be a large project.

At this time we have contracted two weekends in July— Friday, Saturday, & Sunday **July 15th –17th and July 29th-31st**. One hundred fifty appointments will fill each weekend. We must fill the scheduled before we can add additional photo weekends. Additional weekends will likely be scheduled in the fall, with the final pictorial directory being printed in early 2023.

Your photo session will last approximately 12 minutes. You will return within 2 weeks to view your portraits and make any purchases at that time. Whether or not you make a package purchase, you will receive a complimentary 8x10 portrait and a pictorial directory when the directory is completed.

Appointments times are **10:00AM to 8:00PM** on Friday, Saturday and Sunday in the lower level of Seton Catholic High School. Karen Ruhl has agreed to coordinate this project again for us. Appointment sign-ups after Masses will begin the weekend following Easter Sunday. Online appointments will be open after Monday, May 16th, after all prior appointments have been added to the online scheduler. Please consider signing up early to get your preferred time.

We will need additional volunteers to serve as greeters during the photo sessions. This is a great opportunity to meet your fellow parishioners.

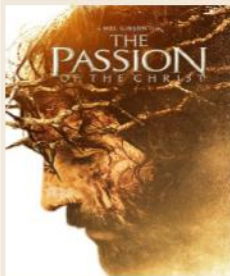

- Preserved 65 shrines connected with the life of Jesus and the prophets.

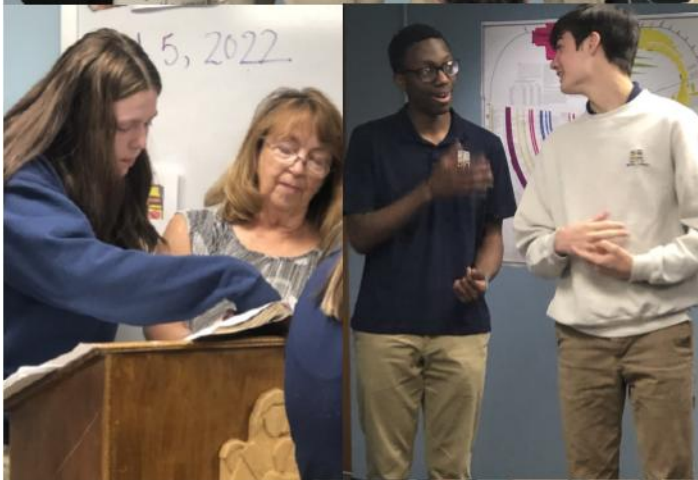
