## Happy Feast of Pentecost!

Today is the birthday of the Church! The Church is entirely and perennially of the Spirit. We must remember that Ascension is all about Jesus' presence, his promise and the subsequent Pentecost. The very opening words of Acts records what Jesus told them, "he charged them not to depart from Jerusalem, but to wait for the promise of the Father." He told them, "...John baptized with water, but before many days you shall be baptized with the Holy Spirit." We must note then, that "Baptism with the Holy Spirit" is the key to Pentecost. Just before Jesus' Ascension, he said, "...you shall receive power when the Holy Spirit has come upon you; and you shall be my witnesses in Jerusalem and in all Judea and Samaria and to the end of the earth" [Acts 1:4-9].

As Jesus went up, so did the disciples – they went up to the upper room! With one accord, they devoted themselves to prayer. The novena that we prayed these past nine days models this prayer in the upper room. They believed in the promise. They prayed for the promise to come true in their life. The outpouring of the Spirit happened! Tongues as of fire, rested on each one of them. This is exactly what Jesus said of "baptism in the Spirit." Right after this incident, Peter, standing with the eleven, preaches – the first incidence of evangelization. Evangelization is not possible unless aided by the Spirit.

John Paul II often talked of the new evangelization – new in ardor, method and expression. Benedict XVI, prayed for the new Pentecost. Pope Francis said that we must be docile to the Holy Spirit. We do need to pray for a new Pentecost for us today, here and now!

What are we to pray for during Pentecost? Some say that we must pray for the fruit of the Spirit or gifts of the Spirit. But, the gifts of the spirit are of the realm of sanctifying grace, meaning, we receive them by virtue of our baptism. Pentecost rather is concerned with charisms – they are dispositions granted for the benefit of others. Chrisms are freely given to those the Spirit apportions.

First of all, grace (Charis) belongs to the supernatural realm. It is not intrinsic to human nature, but is given from above, yet builds on nature (2 Cor 1:12, 1 Pet 1:13). The Greek term Charisma, though cannot be rendered "charism" in English, Paul in several of his texts (e.g., Rom 1:11; 5:15; 6:23; 2Cor 1:11) speaks of what we today mean by "charism," (e.g., 1 Cor 7:7; 1 Cor 12:4-11; Rom 12:3-8 also Eph 4:11). This word derives from the word charis, meaning "grace" (1 Cor 1:7). Charisma then, means, "work of grace," or "gift of grace." It appears seventeen times in the New Testament, of them sixteen occurrences are Pauline and the other 1 Pet 4:10. What is charisma? It is a concrete materialization of God's grace; it is grace differentiated and grace distributed!

If Pentecost means the constitutive moment of the Church, each year it should also mean that the Church is

being constituted and being made perfect. It also means that the Spirit of Christ is at work in us each day! Let us consciously be aware of the work of the Spirit in us!

## Pro-Life Issues

- Evidence suggests that laws restricting the funding of abortion (like the Hyde amendment preventing Medicaid funds from going to abortion) or limiting its availability, involving parents, and providing women with more information lowers the rate of abortion.

**"If you really cared about women and reducing abortion, you would offer free contraception."**

- While some argue that contraception is the key to reducing the abortion rate, real-world evidence does not back that up. Instead, research shows that even when women were provided with free "emergency contraception" ahead of time, the pregnancy and abortion rate remained statistically equivalent with those who were not provided with it.<sup>14</sup> In fact, the availability of contraception and abortion can increase the rate of unintended pregnancies (as well as sexually transmitted infections) as studies show that people engage in more frequent and riskier behavior if they believe their risk has been lowered.

**"Massive numbers of women will face unexpected, traumatic pregnancies because of this."**

- It is possible that less "access" to abortion will ultimately mean fewer women facing unexpected or challenging pregnancies. Since abortion became legal in most states, we have seen an increase in unexpected and challenging pregnancies, not a decrease.
- The overwhelming majority of abortions (86% according to the CDC) take place in the context of non-marital relationships, where women lack the social and financial support of marriage. It has been found that widespread availability of contraception and abortion has helped make non-marital sex more of a cultural norm that in turn leads to more non-marital pregnancies that many women feel unprepared to handle alone.
- Justice O'Connor in *Planned Parenthood v. Casey* wrote that by and large, people have come to understand abortion as the backup for failed contracept- (to be continued on page 4)

tion. If the “abortion backup” becomes less widely available, we could see an important cultural shift that leads both men and women to treat sex with greater respect, and have sex with people only when they are ready for children and open to starting a family. If this happens, the non-marital pregnancy rate could begin to decline.

### “Who will help the women who can’t get abortions?”

- The Church will never cease to do what it has always done- to pray, work, and serve until the day when every human life is protected in law, and welcomed in love. Until that day comes, and ever after, we will continue to care for women and children in need, so that every mother has the support to joyfully choose life.
- Through the expansive social ministries of the Church, we do a lot to help mothers in need, but there are tremendous opportunities on the local and parish level to reach out to women who are pregnant and to provide them with the support to choose life. That is why the Church has started “Walking with Moms in Need,” a parish-based ministry where parishes “walk in the shoes” of pregnant and parenting women, so that they have the emotional and material support they need, so that no one gets left behind.

Pro-life Americans of all faiths have stepped forward to found thousands of pregnancy care centers, and could be counted on to provide even more help as needed. Pro-life activists have been helping these women over the last nearly half-century.”


