# Happy Feast of Corpus Christi

Last Sunday we celebrated the Solemnity of the most Holy Trinity. The Sunday before we celebrated the feast of Pentecost. The feast of today could be considered the feast of the Son, in His most holy Body and Blood. We must never separate the three persons. Each one is God equally and entirely. The Spirit is the Spirit of the Father and of the Son. I want to focus on the work of the Spirit at Mass. The entire liturgy of the Holy Mass is the work of the Spirit, more correctly the work of the Trinity (CCC 1077). The Holy Spirit makes present the mystery and memory of Christ present at Mass. There is a special word to denote the action of the Spirit at consecration of the host and wine, the offering of the faithful to the Body and Blood of Christ - epiclesis. This is an action a priest does hovering over the elements with his two hands - the bells ring! Now, we know it is the community, the body of Christ that is united with its Head, Christ that celebrates the Mass. All baptized members participate in the priesthood of Christ, just as the priest himself participates in Christ's priesthood. As St. Thomas Aquinas teaches, the priest stands in persona Christi, he also stands in persona totius Ecclesia. It is the Spirit that makes this possible, the same Spirit that descended on Jesus and later on the Church. By virtue of the same kind of baptism, the Church continues the sacrifice of Christ.

Of special importance to this point is the response that the people say, "And with your Spirit." It is not simply, "and with you" which is no more than an exchange of religious greeting. We must see it in the same spirit and meaning that Paul used in Gal 6:18, Philem 25 and 2 Tim 4:22. In a way, you remind me and every other priest and

everyone of the community that it is the Spirit that makes the Holy Sacrifice possible in the same intent of Christ. Who else can do it, if not His Spirit? Everytime the people respond, "And with youe Spirit," the priest is particularly reminded of the only reason he was ordained a priest gifted as we priests are for the purpose with the charisma of the Spirit! We should not forget also that every spiritual activity requires the special aid of the Spirit - epiclesis, hence the proclamation of the word of God in the readings for Mass is the work of the same Spirit that inspired the sacred scripture. When the Gospel is proclaimed, the response of the people, "And with your Spirit" comes as a great reminder of that truth!

This day is an important day for the Archdiocese of Indianapolis as we inaugurate the Eucharistic Congress 2024. We will gather with Archbishop Thompson for the Eucharistic procession in downtown Indianapolis. Those of you have reserved a seat in our Bus, please gather at St. Andrew Church parking lot at 1pm. I am excited about this great opportunity to process with the Lord, witnessing His mercy and grace!
