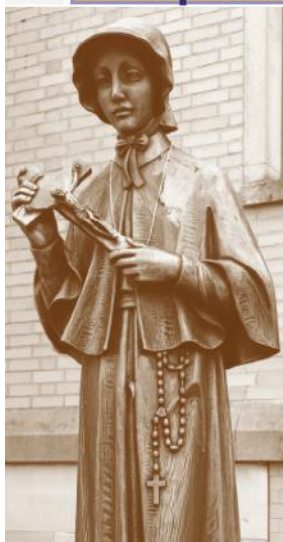
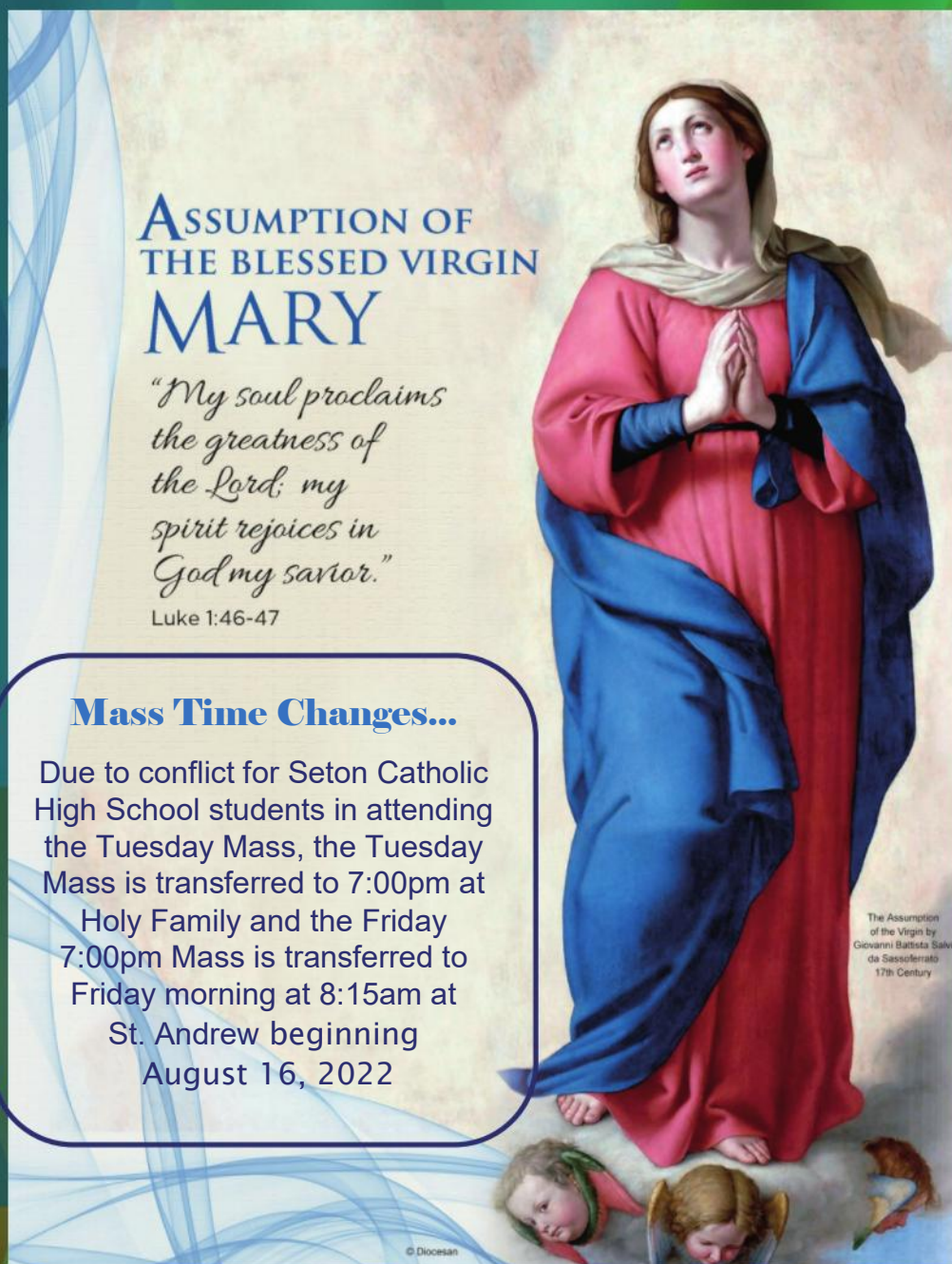

Fruitful Vacation

Dear Parish family,

I am indeed so happy to be back, although my travel got delayed by a week. I did enjoy the extra time with my family. This time my vacation to India was different, in that I had four of our parishioners with me for two full weeks.

Here is a little report on what we did in India! On July 3, 2022 – I was so excited to see Dr. Sam Krutz, Susan Shaw, Laurie Miller and Donnie Miller in Trivandram airport after a 21-hour long flight.

What an exciting time for them and for me! We toured many places, but those places were places of importance for our faith. First, we visited the place of martyrdom of the newest saint – St. Devasahayam at Aralvaimozhi, about 40 miles from my hometown. Second, we visited the cave of St. Francis Xavier at Manapparai, about 60 miles from my hometown. This is the cave where St. Francis Xavier sojourned for two years as he was busy evangelizing the people. Third, we visited our diocesan Shrine of St. Anthony where thousands of people flock every Tuesday. On our way to another place of martyrdom, we visited the famous Hindu Temple in Madurai where Dr. Sam was blessed by the temple elephant (Of course, Dr. Sam did put a sign of the cross on himself right away!!). St. John de Britto was a Jesuit priest ministering in Oriyur where he was martyred for advising one of his coverts, a local king, to dismiss all his wives but one. The place of his martyrdom is still covered by red sand, as it is believed to have been stained by his blood. Ask Dr. Sam if he has some of that sand!

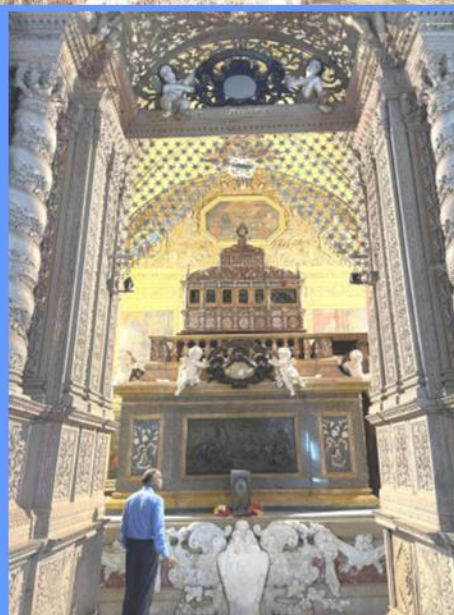
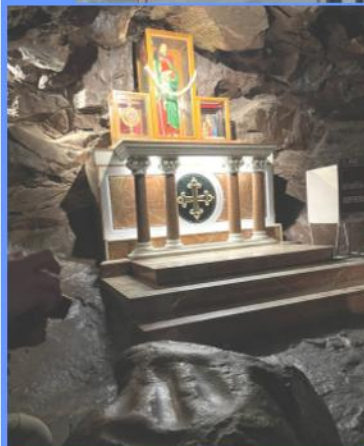
Our visit to St. Thomas Mount was quite an experience. St. Thomas the Apostle is believed to have come to Tamilnadu (my home state), right after the Apostles were commissioned by our Lord and preached the Gospel to the natives. We visited the little cave where he took shelter during a persecution. We also visited and prayed at the rock where he was beheaded. I have no words to explain what I felt when we said Mass over the tomb of St. Thomas!

Then, we flew to Kolkata to visit St. Mother Teresa's tomb and her place of residence and ministry during her entire lifetime. The original charity homes for the disabled, the abandoned babies, those mentally challenged and those of old age, were places of significance for us.


After visiting the Taj Mahal in Agra, another beautiful place no one wants to miss, we flew to Goa to visit the mortal remains of St. Xavier's body in a silver casket at the Bom Jesus Basilica. After returning to my hometown, we were able to visit the school of my childhood. It was another thrilling experience for all of us. Upon request by the local pastor for some help, we were able to donate five brand new computers for the school. We did make some donations to the shrines and the places of martyrdom that we visited. I should say, our trip to India was for most part a pilgrimage, a pilgrimage that we will cherish forever!

A Message from Deacon Jim Miller

I'm sure many of you have been wondering why I haven't been very active in the parish over the last several months. I even heard of a rumor that I was "suspended". (I was not.)

When I was ordained a Permanent Deacon on June 23, 2012, I pledged, as all Permanent Deacons in the Archdiocese do, that I would serve the Church for a minimum of ten years. My 10-year anniversary of ordination was June 23 of this year. It was also my 48th wedding anniversary.

I love my role of serving the Church and you as your Deacon. When Father Kevin passed away in March of 2019 and then a week later, we lost Deacon Frank, our parish was devastated. With barely any time to grieve I shouldered a heavy load overseeing the day-to-day running of the Parish in the absence of our pastor and my friend, Deacon Frank. With Seton Schools opening this week, I will be easing back in to things, beginning with accompanying the Confirmation Class retreat on August 12 and 13.

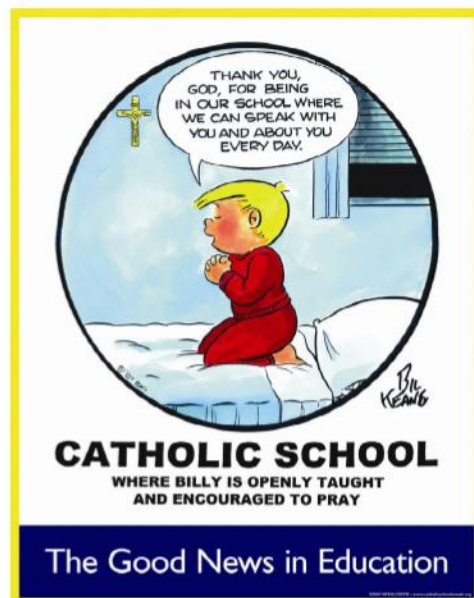

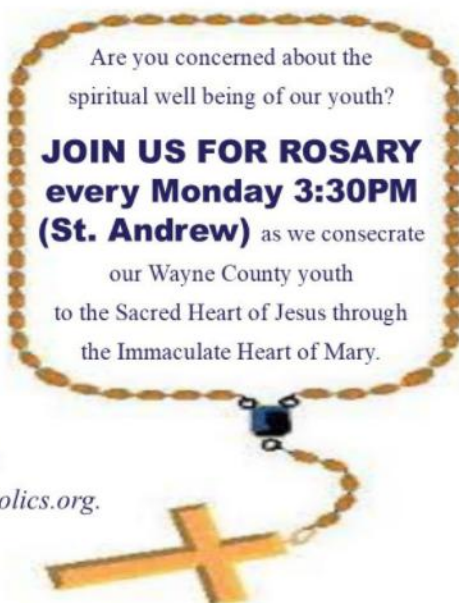
