If you noticed the second reading again comes from the letter to the Hebrews. The passage for today talks about two mountains that are very important in the history of Israel and Christians. Mount Sinai is identified closely with Moses. It is on mount Sinai that he received the ten commandments. It was a forbidding mountain in the wilderness, a place of fear as it was the place of law. Mount Zion on the other hand is a joyful mountain of the heavenly city where God dwells in the midst of his people. The striking feature is that it is not a mountain in a distant future but a place of present reality that Christians already enjoy. Mount Sinai was a place that no one could approach, whereas Mount Zion is a place that all can approach freely!

What is this Mount Zion that we have already approached? It has a striking reference to Mount Calvary! Through the sacrifice of Jesus we are able to approach God with full confidence. Because Christ offered the one, holy and righteous sacrifice on our behalf and in our place, we can freely approach or “worship” on this mountain as people who are made righteous by the blood of Christ. We have a true citizenship in the heavenly city (Phil 3:20). The angels, joined by the assembly (ekklesia - Church - the saints by virtue of baptism - that is us!) denote to the truth of the Mount Zion made visible at each altar, surrounded by Christians offering the sacrifice of Christ.

When people leave the Church, or simply abandon the Holy Mass, this is what they do - they leave this holy mountain which was made approachable by the sacred blood of Christ. They leave the holy Church where God dwells - the city on earth - the heavenly Jerusalem, the city of the living God! Isn't it sad that people have forgotten the basic Catechesis about the Church. Have you ever wondered why your children, all of a sudden, leave the Church? There is no blanket answer to this question but at least we can presume that those who leave the Church were never convinced why they

went to Church in the first place!

Go to Mass! It is more than an obligation!
