

Sin Makes You Stupid!

Years ago, there was a TV game show titled "Are You Smarter than a 5th Grader?" Questions taken from elementary school textbooks tested contestants for prize money.

Once, a Nobel Prize winner won \$1 million dollars. However, many failed and had to admit they were "not smarter than a 5th grader."

The Archdiocese of Indianapolis has Catholic standards for 5th Graders (and all grades). Many are basic like the Sign of the Cross, Hail Mary, and the Lord's Prayer. Fifthgraders are expected to know the Ten Commandments and the 7 Sacraments. After learning the Corporal and Spiritual Works of Mercy in 3rd and 4th grade, students will next learn the Fruits of the Holy Spirit and Prayer to the Holy Spirit. Are you smarter than a 5th Grader at Seton?

If it is difficult to remember the Great Commandment, then pray Matthew 22:37-39 with all your heart, all your soul, and all your mind. For the New Commandment reflect on John 13:34 with love for others. And if the Beatitudes are confusing, then meditate with imagination on Matthew 5:3-10. Contemplating the Scriptures will help Catholics to be more attentive to God's will.

Memorization of these key prayers and practices is not easy for 5th graders (or anyone else). Knowing prayers do aid in the struggle for Faith and open hearts to God's grace. The prize is not simply money but chance to be a saint. And failure in this test is not merely public shame. It may lead to Matthew 7:13 destruction.

Sin makes you stupid! St. Paul put it this way: "Although they knew God, they did not honor him as God or give thanks to Him, but they became futile in their thinking and their senseless minds were darkened." (Rom. 1:21).

The Catechism concludes, "For those who receive the Sacrament of Penance with contrite heart and religious disposition, reconciliation "is usually followed by peace and serenity of conscience with strong spiritual consolation." Indeed the Sacrament of Reconciliation with God brings about a true "spiritual resurrection," restoration of the dignity and blessings of the life of the children of God, of which the most precious is friendship with God (1468)."

The Rite of Christian Initiation of Adults (RCIA) seeks to prepare people to say "yes" to eternal truths. Not simply to be able to pass a test, but to fall in love with the eternal lover, Jesus. Through graces of the Holy Spirit, the RCIA team will share the scriptures, teachings, liturgy and reason to enable those on this journey to be more perfectly configured to Christ. Our RCIA team of Dr. Joseph Moriarity, Beth Van Der Burgt, Laura Elstro, Evelyn Miller, David & Peggy Rokosz, Vicky Roosa, Dr. Sam Krutz and Father Sengole invites everyone to come and see that the Catholic worldview is not just a way of thinking, but the path to true happiness. Please pray for our RCIA team.
