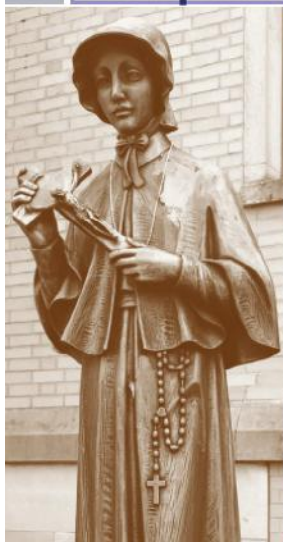

## What is the truth about ourselves?

“God wills everyone to be saved and to come to the knowledge of the truth” – this teaching of Paul, as he writes to Timothy (2<sup>nd</sup> reading for today - 2 Tim 2:1-8) is the most important content of the whole Gospel.

The two most necessities of us humans are truth and salvation. All those who seek will soon realize that only truth will set them free (Jn 8:31). When we say “truth,” we mean the truth about ourselves and the truth about God. That we were created in the image and likeness of God and that we somehow lost this glory due to the corrupting nature of sins is the basic realization about ourselves. That God wills everyone to be saved is the basic realization about God. We believe in a God who wills (not just wants or desires) to save us. We believe in the realization that we need salvation.

Now, only in the light of what is our predicament and the eternal plan of God, we want to understand heaven and hell. Many people now-a-days are of the opinion that heaven and hell are fancy stories of Catholicism. They are not! Our predicament (without being saved) will only subject ourselves to the corrupting nature of sin, the end of it is corrosion - hell! If God wills everyone to be saved, then there must be a place where gathers us all – heaven! Calvin, one of the early protestant theologians was wrong when he preached predestination – a belief that some are predestined to hell and others to heaven, meaning only those predestined by God are saved.

God’s love does not condemn anyone. Heaven is a place of God’s choice for us, hell is a place of our choice for us. Ultimately, what matters most is what we choose over what God chooses for us. Hell is our own choice, and never God’s!

Augustine wrote, “our hearts are restless until they rest in you...” God wants us to rest in him rather than resting in our own designs and ideas about our life. Only truth, beauty and goodness will give us the enduring fulfillment to our hearts, until then we will be restless! The only way to rest is to know what holds for us and to change our life as a result of being touched by His mercy. The gates of heaven are wide open, only that we must choose to go there!

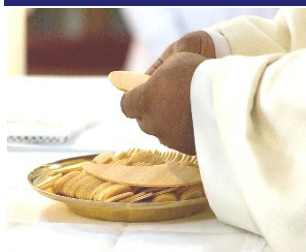

## What is RCIC & What Age Attends?

RCIC refers to the "Rite of Christian Initiation for Chil-  
dren." This is a newer term than RCIA which refers to  
the "Rite of Christian Initiation for Adults." RCIC is the  
process for children to be baptized and enter the Catholic  
Church who have not been baptized as an infant but are  
now passed the age of reason and know right and wrong  
and can thus commit actual sins. It is sometimes called the  
"Rite of Christian Initiation Adapted for Children."

Children usually between the ages of 7 and 14 take part in  
RCIC classes to receive the Sacrament of Baptism and  
enter the Catholic Church. Children in high school older  
than 14 usually will take part in standard RCIA classes.  
Children who are baptized before the age of reason will  
simply begin CCD classes when they start their primary  
education .

RCIC classes start on Sunday, October 9th  
from 12:15 - 1:15 pm in SCHS.

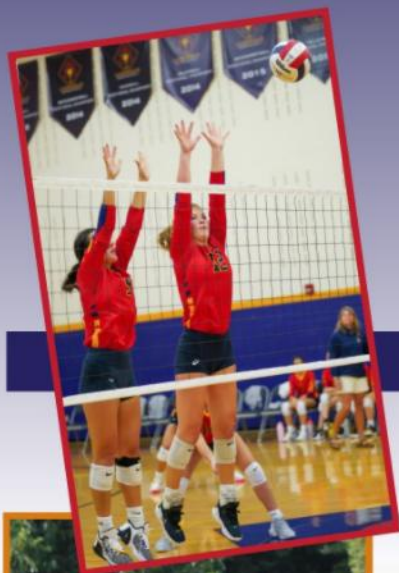
