## A Faithful Person is always a Grateful Person

The story of the ten lepers in the Gospel and the healing of Naaman in the first reading have a strong message for us. That message is “give to God what is due to Him.” What is due to God all the time is gratitude. Gratitude is an act of faith. It is an act of the will. Gratitude is intentional and at the same time deliberate. The one leper who returned to Jesus had only one word to tell Jesus – “Thank you!”

Last week, Jesus said that all we need is faith – faith the size of a mustard seed. We don’t need faith the size of an elephant! If God gives us something, it is enough that we have it a mustard-size. The leper that returned to Jesus had this tremendous expression of faith. Jesus complements that by saying, “Your faith has saved you!” Isn’t it sad that more often than not, we forget what God did for us in His Son? The leper came back not only to give thanks, but also to recognize the person of Jesus who healed him. He knew that faith meant relating to a person. He was moved by a supernatural intervention, because that is what this 1:9 ratio shows. If one person out of ten responds in faith, the other nine have practically ignored this supernatural surge of faith in their hearts and went their own way. If our bodies and souls are restored to full health, they can only find fulfillment in God, not in the pleasures of the world.

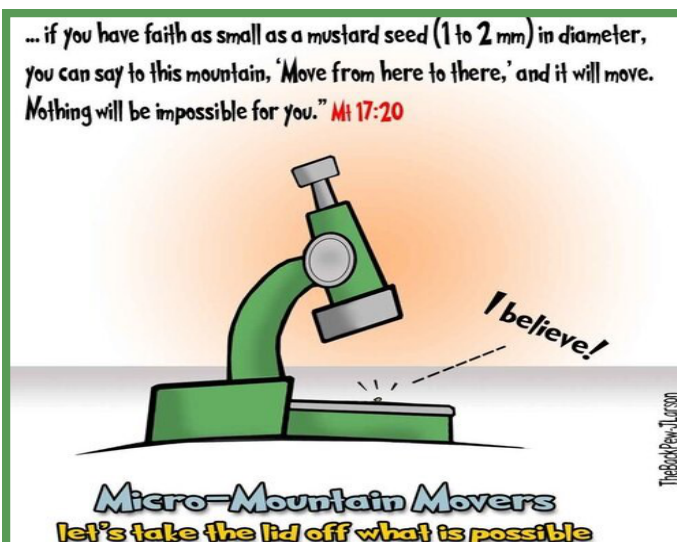
The Catechism teaches (CCC 26-27), “By his Revelation, invisible God, from the fullness of his love, addresses men as his friends, and moves among them, in order to invite and receive them into his own company. The adequate response to this invitation is faith. By faith, man completely submits his intellect and his will to God. With his whole being man gives his assent to God the revealer (the obedience of faith). We have faith, a faith that saves us! Jesus came down from heaven “in order to save us.” On our part, we have nothing to do except to recognize Jesus the Redeemer. A faithful person is a grateful person. A grateful person excels in faith. We have so much to be thankful for.

The best way to say God “Thank you” is to go to Mass. The Greek word **Eucharistia** means “giving of thanks.” We return to God as often as we could on the day our rest to give thanks to God for what God did in Jesus. God continues to speak to us and He continues to save us.

May we always give to God what is due to Him; may we grow to be faithful and grateful to Christ who walks with us each day in our faith journey!

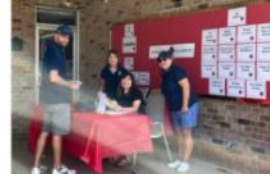
