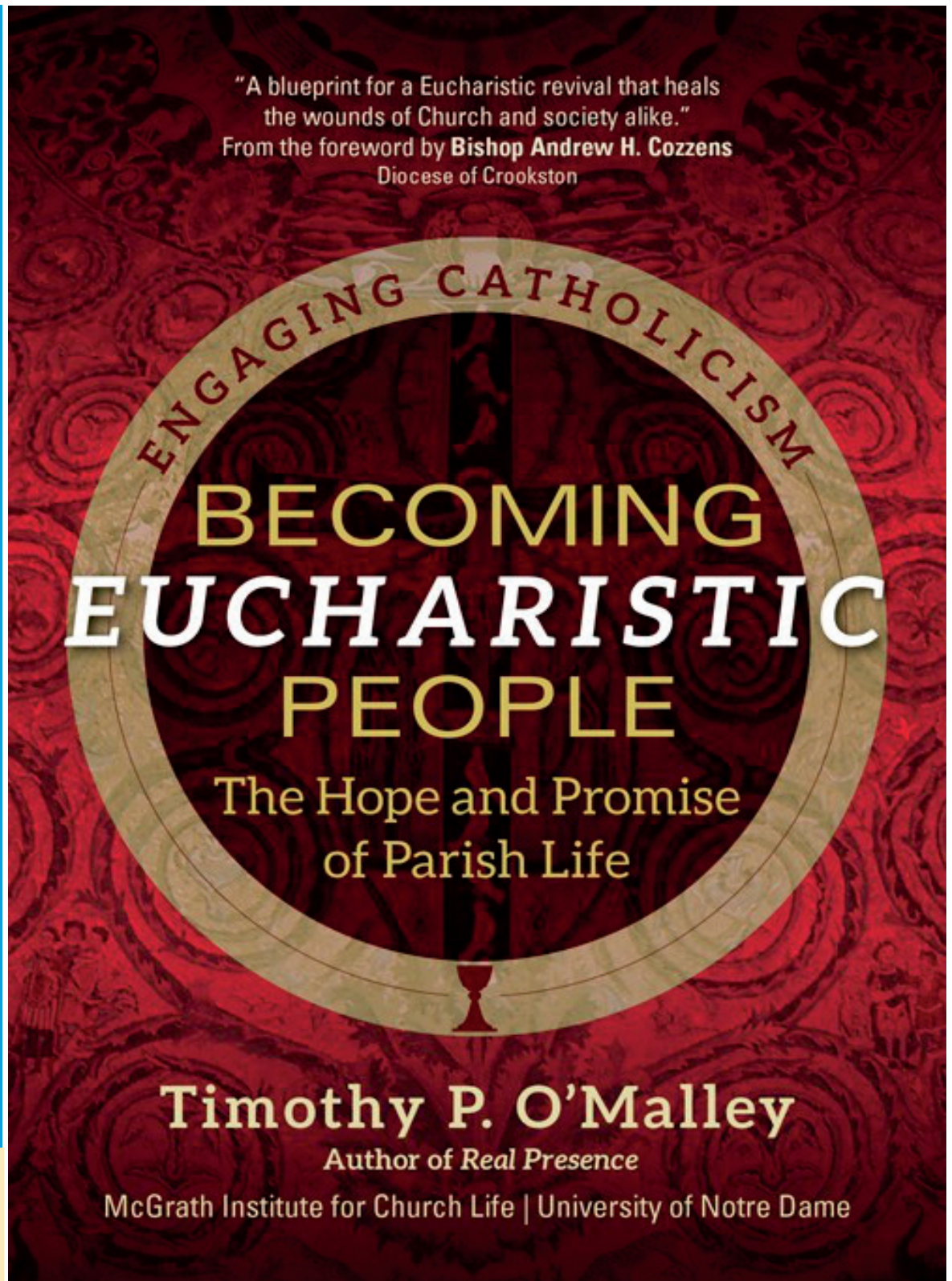

## Eucharistic Revival

As I announced this past weekend, we are going to embark on a book study for the Eucharistic Revival. There are so many books, especially during this time of the revival, for us to keep reading. I picked one book, entitled *Becoming Eucharistic People - The hope and promise of parish life*, authored by Tim O'Malley.

Here is the plan – We are going to form small groups of 5 to 10 people and each day, groups will meet either in our Church or homes to discuss the book for 40 minutes. One of the group members will also be group leaders. Basically, we are trying to form 7 groups of 10 people (Monday through Sunday). On top of that, we will have some existing groups like Catholic Women United, Catholic Men of Action, parish staff and school teachers reading the book.

The Eucharistic Revival is all about reclaiming our Catholic faith in the real presence of the Lord. It is not just by intellectually knowing this but practically translating such a faith into action. We are a Eucharistic people, meaning all our life is centered on the Eucharistic Lord. This revival is not just about the real presence in the monstrance that is used for adoration, but more truly is about reclaiming the sense of encounter at the Holy Mass. It goes without saying, then, that the priesthood is essentially connected to the mystery of the Eucharist. This revival, hence, is also about reclaiming the true meaning and respect for the priesthood. Promoting our young people for priesthood, then, essentially stems out of a Eucharistic culture. All Christian life is oriented to and flows from the Eucharist which is the source and summit of Christian life, as taught by the Second Vatican Council.

I hope you are able to join in this book reading. All that you need to do — visit our parish website, click “Eucharistic Revival” and sign up for the book. The book reading starts in the first week of Lent 2023. If you can’t access the website, please call the parish office to claim your book.
