

ARCHDIOCESE OF INDIANAPOLIS Eucharistic Revival 2022-2025

A Eucharistic Evening of Reflection for priests/PLC's, **staff members (including folks from our schools and others who work with our young people) and key volunteer leaders** from the parish is planned for Thursday, March 16, 2023 at St. Ann Parish, New Castle from 6:30-8:30PM. We encourage you to attend this meeting with other key leaders within our deanery.

The Eucharistic Evening of Reflection is intended to give the participants a powerful encounter with Jesus in the Blessed Sacrament. The gathering will provide a model for similar gatherings that can be offered in parish and school communities and these events will be important and effective ways to motivate and equip our communities to create and initiate a local plan for Year 2 of the Eucharistic Revival.

The evening of reflection will include a time of exposition and adoration of the Blessed Sacrament, a powerful witness of one's experience of the love of our Eucharistic Lord, some discussion and reflection by the participants themselves, and, lastly, a presentation and explanation of several resources that may be used by communities within their local plan for Parish Year of the revival. One such resource will most definitely be a "guide" for holding Eucharistic Processions, which all parishes (or clusters of parishes) are being asked to have on June 11, 2023, the Solemnity of the Most Holy Body and Blood of Christ (Corpus Christi) and the opening of Year 2 of the National Eucharistic Revival.







Praying and Fasting for Lent

The Biblical practice of fasting can be found in both the Old Testament and the New, with Moses (Exodus 34:28; Deuteronomy 9:9-18), Elijah (1 Kings 19:8), and our Lord (Matthew 4:2) all participating in 40-day fasts. Fasting is a way of denying ourselves the excesses and distractions of life so that we might be more aware of the Lord's voice. It is also a way of disciplining yourself, strengthening your "spiritual muscles" so to speak so that when temptations arise in life, you are already used to saying "no" to your desires. And finally, fasting is also a way of participating, in a small way, in the sufferings of Christ and can be particularly powerful when accompanied by prayer and confession.


