Happy Feast of Corpus Christi!

Corpus Christi in Latin means "Body of Christ". This year, we are celebrating a deanery level Corpus Christi procession from St. Andrew Church to Holy Family Church – Today! (June 11, 2023). I hope that everyone from our parish may be able to join. We have planned for this event in such a way that it incorporates all aspects – Procession with the Blessed Sacrament, a small display of Eucharistic Miracles, originally collected by Blessed Carlos Acutis, a talk by national speaker Katie McGrady and then a fellowship meal in the school cafeteria. I want to thank our team from our parish, mostly the members of the Faith Formation committee, who spent a lot of time praying and planning!

I hope this great event brings us renewal and recommitment as disciples of Christ. In today's culture, religion has been pushed aside, watered down, relegated to the margin, if not seen as useless. Likewise, faith in the Real Presence of Jesus in the Most Blessed Sacrament has somehow waned. According to a 2019 Pew Research Center survey, only 31% of self-described Catholics believe that the bread and wine actually become the Body and Blood, Soul and Divinity of Jesus Christ during the consecration at Mass. How can we help dispel such unbelief? I think the key to resolving this should begin from what Jesus said towards the end of his earthly ministry, "And, behold I am with you always, until

the end of the age." His promise of everliving presence among us needs to be discerned with eyes of faith. That means, this saying of Jesus needs to be seen in parallel with his other saying, "This is my body... This is my blood." How could it not be there where he said He will be – the little host and the wine that is transubstantiated into His real body and blood through the action of *epiclesis* (the priest's hovering over of his hands on the elements, invoking the Holy Spirit.)

The Holy Spirit is the principal agent of all renewal and all truth. The Spirit descended on the Church on the day of Pentecost – the Spirit of truth continues to descend even today. St. Paul VI spoke these words on Radio in 1976: "... a mystery great and inexhaustible... let us invite the Holy Spirit to open our hearts to this great mystery!"

As we walk today with the Blessed Sacrament through Main Street, may we be united in prayer for unity and peace in the world. May those who gaze on the Eucharist be filled with awe and wonder – God is with us!



Ways to Celebrate the Eucharistic Adoration

Mass — The Congregation kneels as the priest lifts the Sacrament, declaring: "This is the Lamb of God, who takes away the sins of the world." At communion, each individual bows in front of the Blessed Sacrament before receiving Our Lord under the appearance of bread and wine. Exposition — In some parishes, the Blessed Sacrament is exposed for adoration and day a week. People sign up for a special hour or simply drop by whenever convenient for personal prayer before the Blessed Sacrament. Forty Hours Devotion — Forty semi-continuous hours of adoration of the Eucharistic, held annually in some parishes. Perpetual Adoration — Continuous exposition of the Blessed Sacrament for the purpose of uninterrupted adoration, twenty-four hours a day, seen days a week. Church Visit — A short visit to a church for the purpose of greeting the Blessed Sacrament reserved in the tabernacle. Benediction — After a period of exposition and adoration, the Blessed Sacrament is used to bless the congregation. Eucharistic hymns, most often O Salutaris Hostia and Tantm Ergo, are traditionally sung. Procession — A sacred parade in which clergy and faithful walk form one place to another, giving praise, thanks, and worship to God, especially by adoring the Blessed Sacrament. (OSV)






