


Dear parishioners,

I was very pleased with the turnout for the Corpus Christi adoration and the talk by Katie McGrady. Many parishioners told me that they were grateful for this great opportunity to listen to a national speaker here in Richmond. Unfortunately we were deterred by inclement weather to host the long-awaited procession! But all went

well except the procession. I am grateful to the team that worked so hard to make the dinner a huge success. It was a great time of fellowship!

The 40-hour adoration was well-attended too. Thank you, everyone, for taking the time to spend time with the Lord. I would like to repeat this at least twice a year to pray for some special intention. This may pave the way for preparing our parish

for a perpetual adoration. As always, I do not want to rush in making decisions that concern utmost care such as dealing with the Blessed Sacrament.

The Eucharistic Revival is slowly happening in our parish. At the same time, the revival is not about "Jesus in the monstrance," but "Jesus in the Mass" - the supreme sacrament of God's ever-abiding presence and unity. We need to learn to encounter and adore the Lord at Mass which in turn will fine tune our life of adoration!

What kind of effect our recent 40-hour adoration should create in our parish? Simple - an increased sense of awe and wonder for the humility of our God in the real presence of the Eucharist - the Holy Mass? Would you consider encouraging your children to serve at Mass? Would you consider preparing yourself making a good confession? Would you be willing to go out in search of

> the lost and the poor to bring them to Jesus, to Mass? Adoration of Jesus in the blessed sacrament is, of course, for our own personal growth in holiness - not a mere comfort time - we should be able to see and take the direction such adoration might show us! Where does the Lord lead you in your personal as well as communal life?

For Mother Teresa, adoration of the blessed sacrament was

never a comfort place, it was her charging station! It was her whole life! Her life with the Lord and with the poor was one and the same! How about us?

Why Make a Eucharistic Pilgrimage?

A Journey TO Jesus:

A pilgrimage is "the simultaneous movement of the feet and the soul"—a journey made both externally and internally. The pilgrim travels to a location of spiritual significance, stepping outside of themselves in order to encounter God in places where he has revealed himself. This action mirrors the interior journey of the pilgrim, who uses this experience to draw closer to Our Lord and seek him more intentionally. The value of a pilgrimage is not in the distance traveled but in the disposition of our own hearts and the zeal with which we seek God. Many saints have had life-changing experiences while on pilgrimage, and the practice has been a part of Christianity from the beginning.

A Journey WITH Jesus:

Jesus doesn't want us to walk alone. At the Incarnation, Christ entered directly into our human experience, allowing him to accompany us through life in a more intimate way. But physically walking with Jesus is not a privilege restricted to Christians from the first century! When Jesus gave us the gift of the Eucharist, he gave us a new way to walk alongside him. Catholicism now has a vibrant history of Eucharistic processions! In this tradition, the Eucharist is carried through the streets, accompanied by the faithful. We walk publicly with Our Lord so that others may encounter him personally, just as they did 2,000 years ago.

What Is a Eucharistic Pilgrimage?

The National Eucharistic Pilgrimage is a truly unique initiative. This is something NEW—a beautiful fusion of the journey TO Jesus and the journey WITH Jesus. What's more, it is an adventure that all Catholics can do together, either by interior disposition or physical accompaniment. This is the birth of something remarkable. Join us as we accompany Jesus in the Eucharist from the north, south, east, and west edges of our country, stopping at many holy sites and churches along the way. Together we will journey with Christ on his way to the 10th National Eucharistic Congress, where he comes to encounter his people anew.


