Time to be thinking about Eucharistic Revival Congress!

Dear parish family,

It is time to be thinking about the National Eucharistic Congress that will he held at Indianapolis beginning July 17 and ending on July 21 next year. It is exactly 1 year from now! The greatest news for us is that it is happening right where we live—Indiana. Compared to those far off from Indiana, for whom this will involve lots of spending, we have no reason to excuse based on spending! As of now 26,000 tickets have already been purchased.

We will soon role out an online "pre-registration form" to determine how many would attend from our parish. Once after, we know a definite number, Lynn Lineback and Dr. Sam Krutz will plan on purchasing tickets for the parish. We will try to see if we can further subsidize. Archdiocese of Indianapolis has already reduced the ticket to \$ 274 from \$299. Please stay tuned for more information!

How can I reserve a hotel room with the NEC event rates?

• In order to access our special event rates for hotels, you will first need to register for your Congress Pass. The link to our housing portal will be included in your registration confirmation email.

Where will I be staying?

- Most attendees will purchase a standard Congress Pass with the option to book a hotel room within our discounted housing block. This puts the decision power in your hands to select your preferred hotel based on location, price point, amenities, etc., and also allows you to choose your own roommates. After completing registration, you will receive a housing portal link in your registration confirmation email where you can reserve a hotel room at the special event rate.
- We will be offering alternative housing for parish youth groups as well as seminarians. These alternative housing options will include university dorms and/or church sleep spaces, allowing for more cost-efficient housing for these groups.
- If you request an alternative housing space, a confirmation email with your alternative housing placement will be sent in mid-May 2024. If you do not see one at that time, please contact the National Eucharistic Congress housing team.




