Faith of St. Peter

This week's Gospel text is one of those crucial texts in which we find a lesson on faith. Peter's confession of faith is awarded with praise and promise! Praise for being receptive to the revelation of God the Father and promise of his primacy; the primacy of Peter among all Apostles is seen as Kephias (Aramaic word for rock) – a "Rock-like" faith on which the Church would stand, professing and confessing the same faith – that Jesus is Lord! We must pray for faith each day, for faith like Peter's!

For this reason, Tradition has seen in Peter a sign of unity in the Church: "The ministry of this power was also granted to the other Apostles and to all the bishops of the Church; but the fact that it is given to one in the name of all is significant: the power is granted to Peter in a special way because Peter is the head of all the pastors of the Church" (St. Leo the Great).

From the beginning, this gift to Peter has been interpreted as something that is inherited by his successors, the bishops of Rome. This doctrine of the primacy, together with that of the infallibility of the Pope when he speaks ex cathedra, was defined as a dogma of faith in the Dogmatic Constitution Pastor Aeternus of the First Vatican Council, and it has been reaffirmed in later documents: "The bishop of Rome, in whom rests the function given in a unique way to Peter, the first of the Apostles, and which he passed on to his successors, is head of the college of bishops, the Vicar of Christ and Pastor of the universal Church on earth; he has, therefore, by virtue of his function, ordinary power which is supreme, full, immediate and universal in the Church, and which he can exercise freely" (Code of Canon Law, can. 331; cf. Vatican II, Lumen gentium, 18).

The saints have seen love for the Church and the Pope as a true sign of love for Christ: "He who disobeys the Christ on earth [the Pope], who acts for Christ in heaven, will not partake of the fruit of the blood of the Son of God" (St Catherine of Siena, Epistolae, 207).

Let us pray for faith like St. Peter and also pray for Pope Francis for his commitment to lead the Church in place of St. Peter in today's world!

Religious Education (CCD) 2023-2024 has JOYFULLY begun! So blessed to see many returning faces and new ones too! Registration is ongoing and open to all Pre-K/K through 12th grade students. Please prayerfully consider sharing the gift of your child, with Jesus and His Church, and register him/her in Religious Education this year. SEE YOU SUNDAY!

The Archdiocese of Indianapolis requirements for Sacramental Preparation are as follows:

FIRST HOLY EUCHARIST – Is a TWO-YEAR program. Child must be registered in 1st grade and attend regularly-scheduled classes. The 2nd grade “Sacramental” year will prepare their hearts for JESUS and the sacraments of First Reconciliation and First Holy Communion. Your child must be enrolled in the two-year program in order to make their First Holy Communion. No exceptions.

SACRAMENT OF CONFIRMATION – Is a THREE-YEAR program. Teens must be registered and attend regularly-scheduled 9th and 10th grade Sunday morning Religious Education classes. In January of their 10th grade year they will start Monthly Confirmation classes, in addition to their Sunday Religious Education class. Confirmation candidates will be expected to attend two Confirmation retreats/events during the summer of their 11th grade year. Candidates who have successfully completed the requirements of this program will joyfully receive the Sacrament of Confirmation in the fall of their 11th grade year.
