

Eucharistic Congress

As I announced this past weekend, our parish is going to offer a subsidy to encourage and promote participation of our parishioners in the Eucharistic Revival Congress on July 17-21, 2024. As we know, the last Eucharistic Congress was held more than 50 years ago. We live in a historic time when another Congress takes place right in Indiana. We have no reason to not attend! What a wonderful event this would be to join about 80,000 to 100,000 people in one location to learn, pray, praise and adore! Take a look at the Congress website, it is already packed with tons of information.

Our parish is offering the event ticket which is \$274 with using code: INDY24. On top of that, we will also reimburse you for incidental expenses not exceeding \$300. We are offering this subsidy to 50 people – first come, first serve! As Bishop Cozzens, the convenor for the Revival said, "We seek to create a movement of Catholics across the United States, healed, converted, formed, and unified by an encounter with Jesus in the Eucharist — and sent out in mission 'for the life of the world." We live in an age and culture where faith in general is pushed to the margins of one's life. Christian faith flourishes in healthy families and healthy parishes. To make one's family/ parish a healthy one, we must experience God's abounding presence. For Catholics, the Eucharist remains the source and summit of Christian life. The Eucharist is the source of heavenly graces and it is the summit as we try to become Eucharistic following the footsteps of our Lord. Christ remains the source and the summit of Christian perfection. As often as we encounter Christ in the Eucharist, we are transformed to heal the broken world.

The second news is that we are having a parish retreat this Saturday, September 16, beginning 8:15am with Mass and ending at 3:00pm at Holy Family Campus. We continue to reflect on the insights that we gained from "Becoming Eucharistic People" that we read this past




